VITAL STATISTICS SUMMARY

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## INTRODUCTION

This report contains a summary presentation in tabular form of the vital events which occurred during the year 1975.

In the interest of easy comparison, the same format of tabular presentation has been continued herein as was initiated in the 1968-1969 summary. Counties (and Cities over 10,000 population) are grouped within the 13 standard districts established by Executive Order on August 6, 1969.

Population data are the official 1975 estimates for the State of Washington.



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1975 VITAL STATISTICS NARRATIVE FOR SUMMARY

GENERAL POPULATION:

The State of Washington had a net gain of 46,024 persons in the official population estimate for April 1, 1975. This represents an increase of 1.3% over 1974, and 2.4% since 1970. The non-white population is estimated at 181,400 for 1975, with 45.0% of these (81,600) being Black. The Blacks and persons of Spanish descent are the largest ethnic groups in the State, and represent 2.3% and 2.4% of the total population, respectively.

The population aged 65 and older is estimated at 360,870 for 1975, which is an increase of 40,160 (12.5%) since 1970. There has been an estimated net immigration of 14,700 persons 65 years and older between 1970 and 1975.

NATALITY

Although there were 725 more livebirths in Washington in 1975 than there were in 1974, the birthrate remains unchanged at 14.5 per 1,000 estimated population, due to the larger population estimate for the current year.

The 5,107 illegitimate livebirths amounted to more than 10% of the 50,821 total births, and represent an increase of 7.4% over 1974 when the 4,729 illegitimate births were 9.4% of the 50,096 total.

MORTALITY

There were 5 more deaths (29,778) recorded in 1975 than in 1974. This resulted in the death rate per 1,000 population dropping from 8.6 in 1974 to 8.5 in 1975, a reduction due to an increase of the population base.

Death rates for 13 selected causes of death in the State of Washington for the 21-year period 1955 - 1975 were examined.

Of the thirteen causes surveyed, all except homicide were among the ten leading causes of death at some time during this 21-year span. The causes selected include heart disease; malignant neoplasms; cerebrovascular disease; all accidents; influenza and pneumonia; certain causes of mortality in early infancy; congenital malformations; diabetes mellitus; arteriosclerosis; cirrhosis of the liver; bronchitis, emphysema, and asthma; suicide; and homicide.

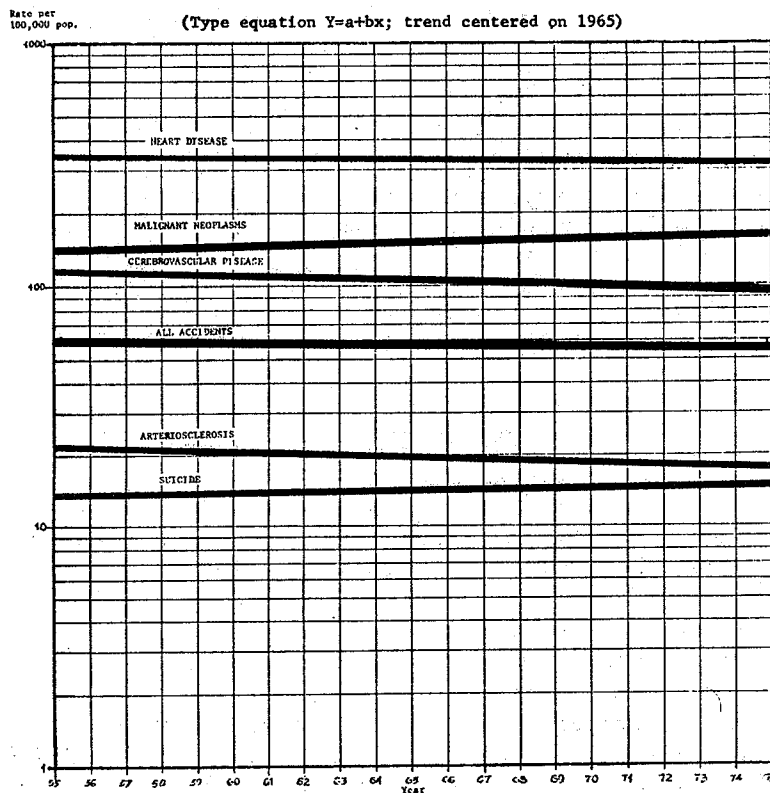
A straight line regression,  $Y=a + bx$ , was calculated for six of the death causes where visual inspection indicated that it would give the best fit. These causes included heart disease, malignant neoplasms, cerebrovascular disease, all accidents, arteriosclerosis and suicide.

In calculating trend lines, certain of the causes had to be eliminated from consideration. The combination category of bronchitis, emphysema and asthma has only been tabulated as such since 1968. The definition of certain causes of mortality in early infancy--a rather inclusive category--in 1968 and after, was not comparable with the definitions listed in the International Classification of Diseases, Seventh Edition, which was in use from 1955 until 1968.

The rate trend for the deaths from diabetes and "influenza and pneumonia" calculated as a level line at 14.8 and 27.4 respectively and were not plotted in Figure I.

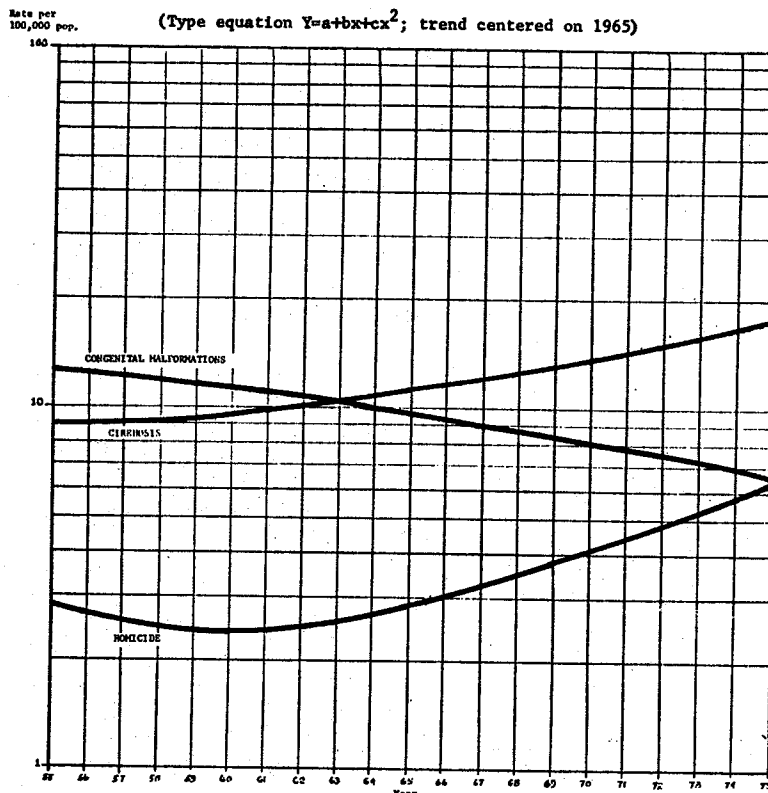
STRAIGHT-LINE TREND OF DEATH RATES PER 100,000 POPULATION

The crude death rate for the State of Washington, from all causes of death, has declined from 9.4 per 100,000 in 1955 to 8.5 per 100,000 in 1975. Meaningful interpretation of the depicted trends will require further refinement of the rates, including age and sex adjustment.

In Figure 2 we have fitted curved trend lines of these death causes whose rate changes in the death rate during the 1955-1975 period indicated that a curved trend would give the best fit.

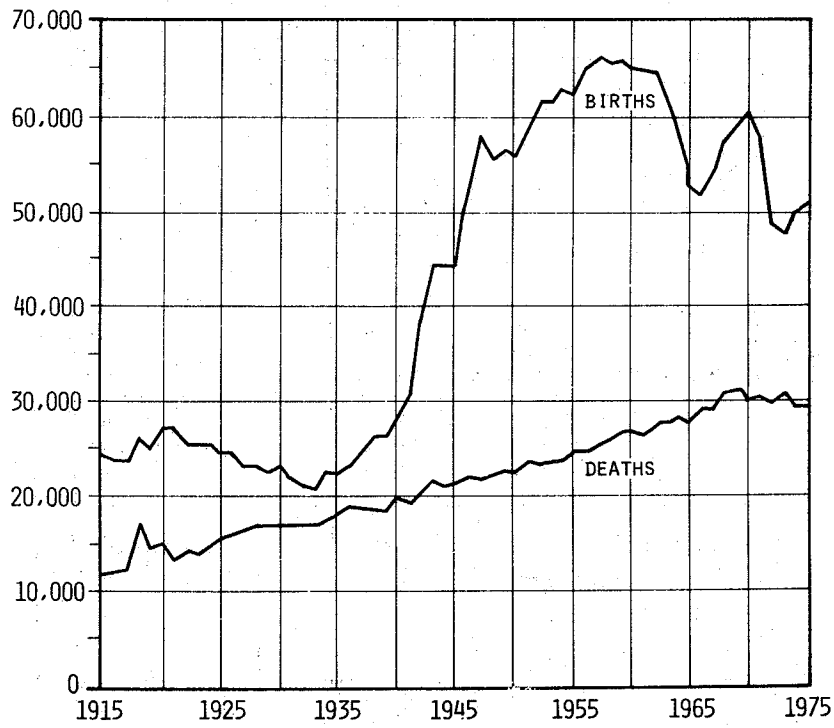


Congenital malformation death rates have declined since the early 1960's. This has contributed to the decreasing infant mortality rate (down from 24.4 per 1,000 livebirths in 1955 to 16.7 per 1,000 in 1975).

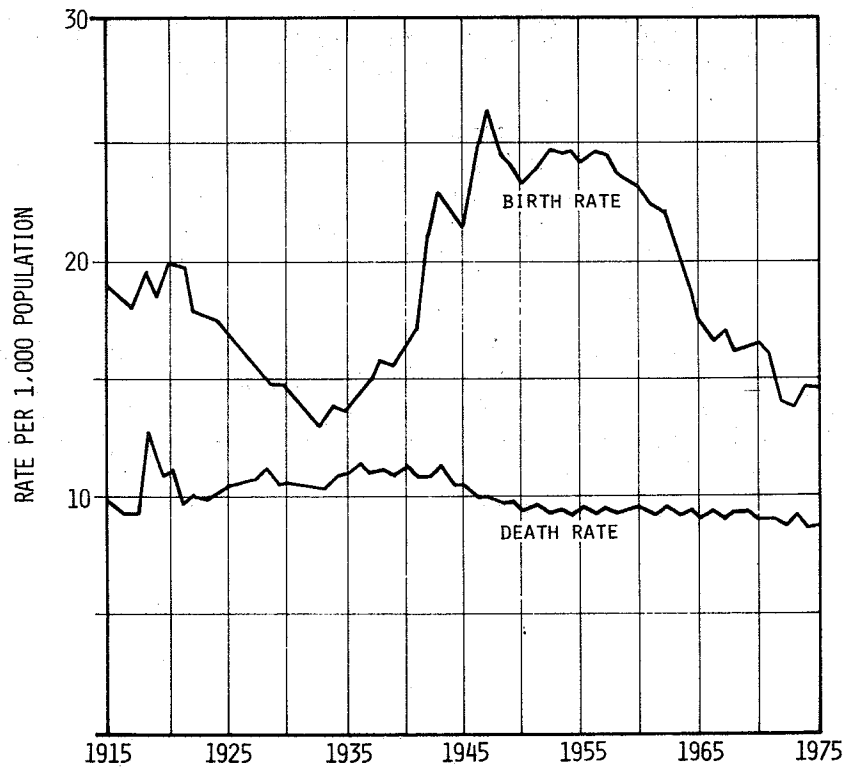
The two most sharply rising trends among the 13 selected causes of death in the past few years for Washington State are seen in the death rates for cirrhosis of the liver and homicide. The trend curve for cirrhosis started to rise in 1957. The homicide death rate reached its lowest point about 1959-1960, and since that time has risen at an increasing rate.

We have no firm forecasts at the present time as to where these trends can be expected to level off from the changes we now see. Should present conditions continue, we can expect these trends will show an increasingly greater climb as the death rates for these causes go up.

### Births and Deaths 1915 - 1975

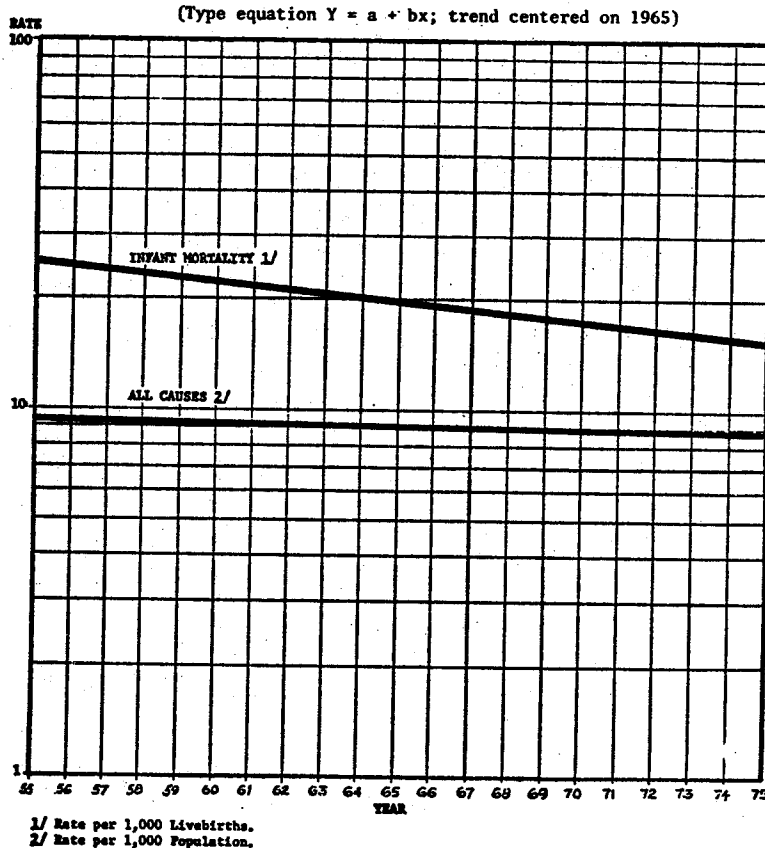


### Birth and Death Rates 1915 - 1975

### INFANT MORTALITY

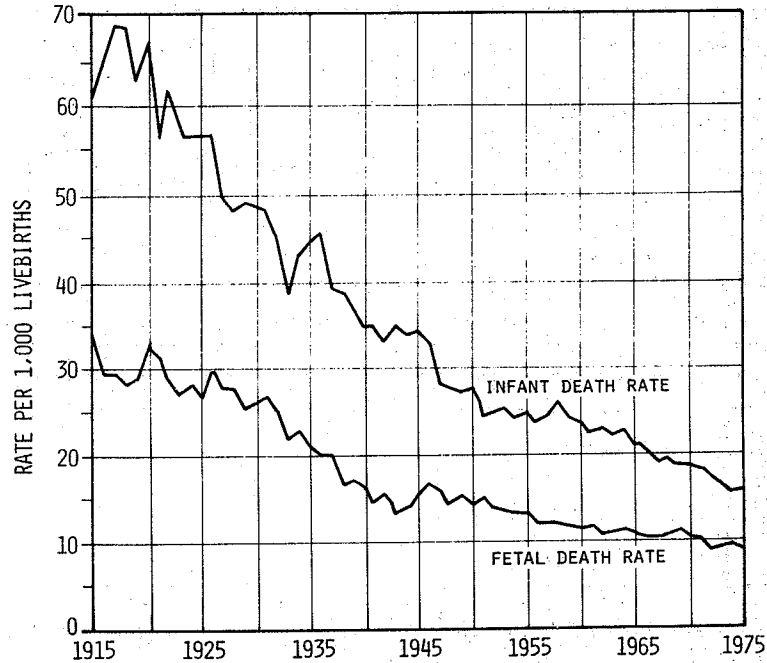
There was an increase of 35 infant deaths in 1975 (798) over the previous year, which resulted in a rate of 15.7 per 1,000 livebirths. This rate is higher than 1974, but lower than any other year.

The Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) was first listed as a separate cause of death in the International Classification of Disease, Adapted (ICDA), 8th Revision, in 1974. These data to date are somewhat limited for trend analysis. There were 119 SIDS deaths reported in 1975, a slight increase over the 116 reported in 1974.

### FETAL DEATHS

There were 29 fewer fetal deaths (421) in Washington this year than last year, resulting in a ratio of 8.3 fetal deaths to 1,000 livebirths. This is the lowest ratio on record.

### MATERNAL DEATHS

Five maternal deaths in 1975, up one from 1974, raised the rate per 10,000 livebirths from 0.8 to 1.0. Four of the five deaths were of White mothers, the other was Black. The age distribution shows one death each in the 15-19 and 20-24 year age groups, with the remaining three deaths in the 25-29 year group.

### MARRIAGE AND DISSOLUTION

There were 41,767 marriages performed in 1975, 160 more than 1974, an increase of 0.4%. On the other hand, the total terminations of marriage (25,783) increased by 1,840 (7.7%) from 1974. Of these terminations, 153 were annulments and 51 were separate maintenance decrees. In 39 cases, the type of decree was not stated.

## BACKGROUND

### RELIABILITY OF THE DATA

In analyzing any data, the possibility of errors in the data must not be overlooked. There are several types of possible errors, including under-registration, errors made by the informant, and errors in compilation and processing. The most potentially dangerous error, however, is probably that of improper interpretation.

Statistics are neither more true nor false than the interpretation given to them. It should be emphasized that most of the rates computed in this report are crude rates. For comparing geographic areas, crude rates are limited. They do not reflect differences in age, sex, race, and other population characteristics. In addition, it is important to recognize the possible distortion in these rates where the number of events or the population is small. Minor variations in the number of events may result in major changes in the rates. Special caution should also be exercised in analyzing trend data, because of changes throughout the years in medical diagnosis, coding definitions, and registration coverage.

### POPULATION

Population data in this report is an estimate of population, April 1, 1975, provided by the Office of Program Planning and Fiscal Management, House Office Building, Olympia, Washington.

### RATES

Rates are calculated by dividing the event of concern by the population at risk or a related population and multiplying by a constant. Death rates from all causes and livebirths are expressed in terms of 1,000 estimated population; deaths from a specific cause are based on 100,000 estimated population (excluding maternal and infant causes); maternal deaths are calculated per 10,000 livebirths; infant, neonatal and fetal deaths are calculated per 1,000 livebirths.

### CAUSE OF DEATH CLASSIFICATION

The causes of death presented herein are classified in accordance with the Eighth Revision of the International Classification of Diseases, Adapted, 1967; Public Health Service Publication No. 1693, U. S. Government Printing Office.

Specific causes of death in this report are shown in groupings of 79 causes. Leading causes were selected from a consolidation of these 79 causes.

### RATES AND WHOLE NUMBERS

Rates are rounded to the nearest tenth. When the rate or percent is less than one-tenth, the entry is left blank.

When whole numbers are used, a blank or dash (-) indicates none or zero.

## DEFINITIONS

GENERAL TERMS

BIRTH WEIGHT - Weight of fetus or infant at time of delivery (normally recorded in pounds and ounces).

FETAL DEATH - A birth after 20 weeks gestation which is not a live birth.

GESTATIONAL PERIOD - Number of weeks elapsed between the first day of the last menstrual period and date of delivery.

INFANT DEATH - Death of an infant under one year of age.

LIVE BIRTH - A birth that shows any sign of life after delivery.

LIVE BIRTH ORDER - Order number is equal to number of previous livebirths plus current birth.

MATERNAL DEATH - Death attributable to complications of pregnancy, childbirth, or the puerperium.

NEONATAL DEATH - Death of an infant within the first 27 days of life.

OCCURRENCE DATA - Data allocated by place where event occurred, regardless of the person's place of residence.

PERINATAL DEATH - Includes stillbirths and deaths to infants within the first six days of life.

PREMATURE BIRTH - A livebirth weighing 5 1/2 pounds (2,500 grams) or less. If birth weight is not stated, length of gestation (under 37 weeks) is used.

RESIDENCE DATA - Data allocated by place of residence of the decedent (deaths), or by place of residence of the child's mother (births, stillbirths).

RATES

AGE-SPECIFIC DEATH RATE - Number of deaths in a specific age group per 100,000 population in that age group.

CAUSE-SPECIFIC DEATH RATE - Number of deaths from a specific cause per 100,000 population.

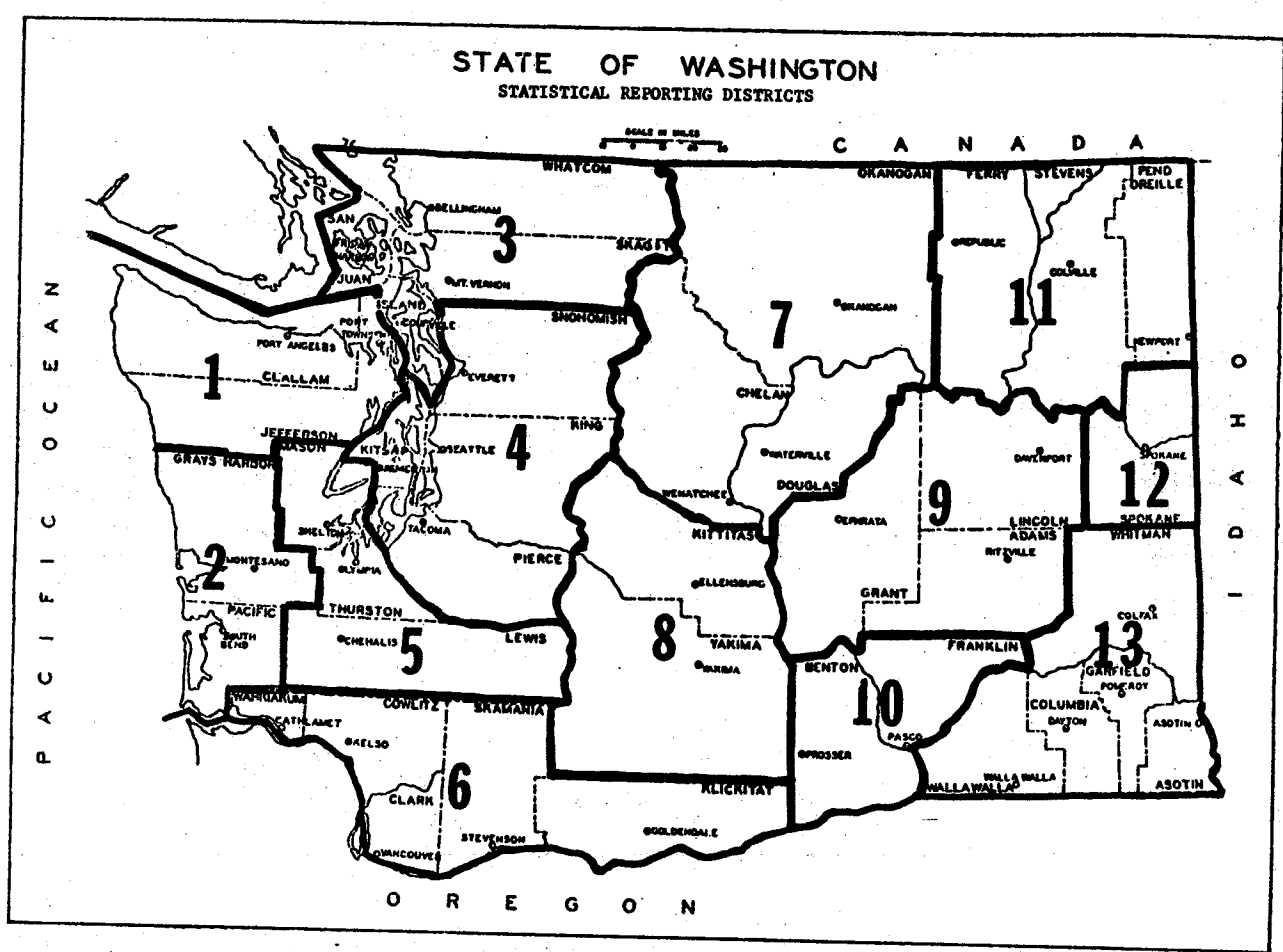
(CRUDE) BIRTH RATE - Number of live births per 1,000 population.

(CRUDE) DEATH RATE - Number of deaths per 1,000 population.

FERTILITY RATE - Number of livebirths per 1,000 women 15-44 years of age.

FETAL DEATH RATE - Number of stillbirths per 1,000 livebirths.

- ILLEGITIMACY RATE - Number of illegitimate livebirths per 1,000 livebirths.
- INFANT DEATH RATE - Number of infant deaths per 1,000 livebirths.
- MATERNAL DEATH RATE - Number of maternal deaths per 10,000 livebirths.
- NEONATAL DEATH RATE - Number of neonatal deaths per 1,000 livebirths.
- PERINATAL DEATH RATE - Number of perinatal deaths per 1,000 livebirths, plus fetal deaths.

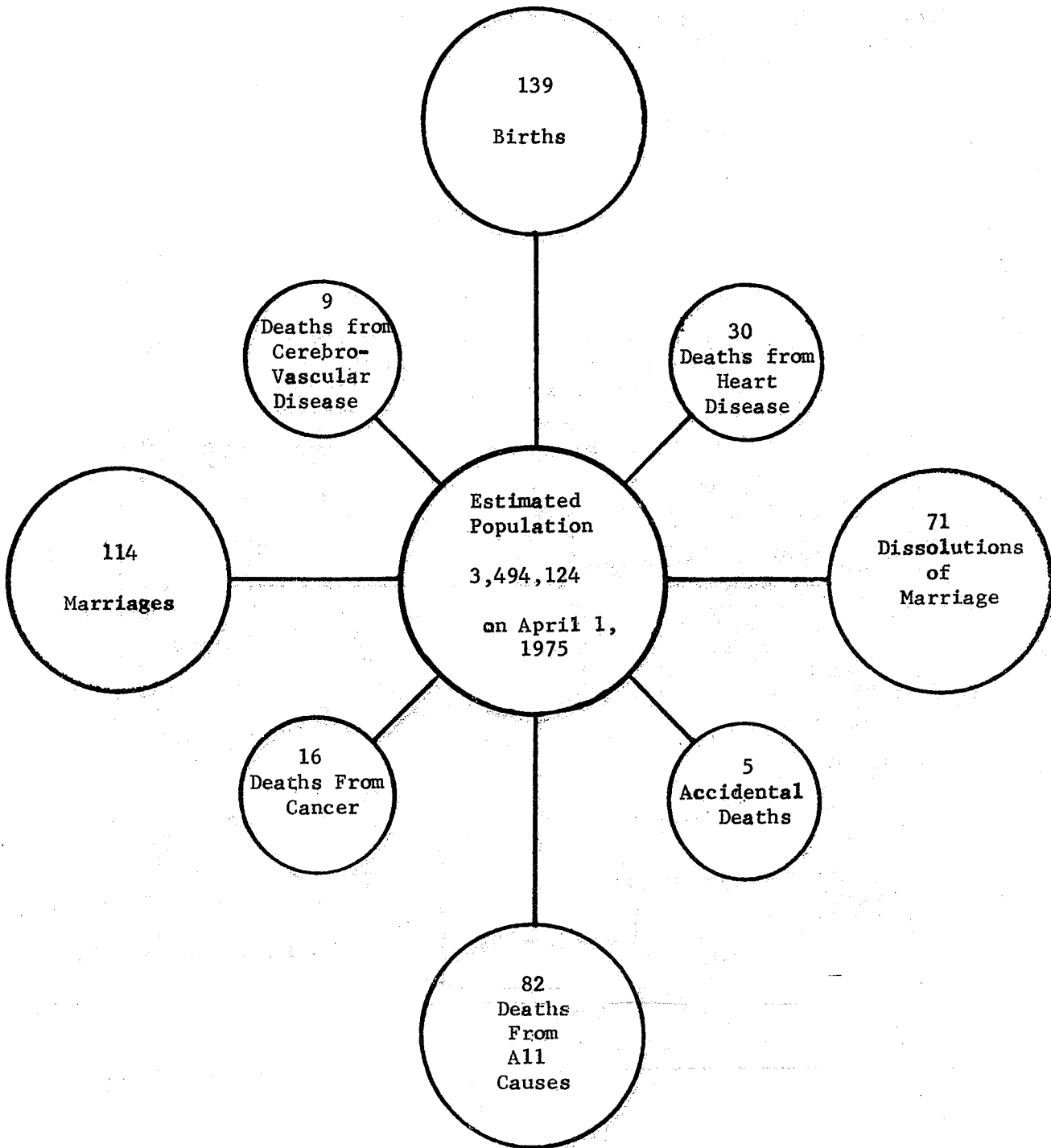
