- Bibliography in APA format
- Citations in APA format
- Reflection: A separate document or section of your project that provides a discussion of the process of your project, including:
  - A brief description summarizing your process
  - Barriers and challenges you experienced over the course of the project.
  - Influences on your work and thinking (i.e., people, media, readings, etc.).
  - Support you received throughout the project.
  - A lesson you learned that can be used in future lived-experiences

	<p><b>Problem identification:</b>            Defines a problem you are trying to solve using WTN data.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Selects a health issue that can be identified, discussed, or supported with WTN data</li> <li>• Identifies why this issue is should be improved</li> </ul>	
	<p><b>Recommendation:</b>            Identifies a possible solution/strategy to improve health or health equity for the identified problem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solution is relevant to the problem</li> <li>• Solution is feasible</li> <li>• Explores possible other solutions before making a recommendation for one that is demonstrated to be best</li> </ul>	
	<p><b>Content:</b>            Covers topic in-depth with details and examples. Demonstrates subject knowledge.</p>	

	<p><b>Quality of information:</b> Information clearly relates to the main topic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Includes supporting details and/or examples.</li> </ul>	
<b>Impact</b>		
	<p><b>Significance:</b> Student clearly defines why topic has a health impact or social significance. Claims are based on the data/evidence and the reasoning they provide.</p>	
	<p><b>Impact:</b> Discusses the impact of implementing the recommended solution, with supporting data where possible.</p>	
	<p><b>Equity:</b> Provides a discussion of the equity impact of their project and demonstrates an understanding of the equity issues surrounding their project.</p>	
<b>Presentation</b>		
	<p><b>Format:</b> Format of the project presentation suits the information presented.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Information is easy to understand</li> <li>• Amount of information is appropriate for the medium</li> <li>• Uses data visualizations</li> </ul>	
	<p><b>Organization:</b> Content is well organized using headings, bulleted lists, or clear sections of video presentation to group related material.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Accurate APA Citation</li> <li>• Accurate, complete bibliography</li> <li>• Headings and sections that are coherent</li> </ul>	
	<p><b>Diagrams &amp; Illustrations:</b> Diagrams and illustrations are accurate and add to the audience's understanding of the topic.</p>
