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## Client Services – Update 6.1.7

### Fixed Issues

- This release removes two invalid reasons from the client termination letter: “You/your child do not have a nutrition risk that meets WIC guidelines.” and “You are no longer pregnant.” The letter was reformatted to accommodate this change.
- Following the letter change, the termination reason “Not risk eligible” has also been removed from the Termination Reason dropdown on the Terminate Client screen.

## Client Services – Update 6.1.4

### Fixed Issues

- Client Services now allows a hemoglobin (HGB) value of less than 6.0 to be entered in the Measures tab of a certification. The new range is 1.0 – 24.0.
- On the Income Documentation tab of a Recertification, Number in Household now carries over from the previous certification. When NEW is pressed to add an income

line, Number in Household and eligibility check boxes (Medicaid, TANF, Basic Food, FDPIR) are not blanked out.

## **Client Services – Update 6.1.2**

### **Fixed Issues**

- The Substitute Foods window is larger to enable viewing all the foods without scrolling; the size of the arrows used to select quantity is larger.
- The mother/baby link question no longer pops up when an infant is already linked to a mother.
- When printing a single no-show letter, the displayed message is now grammatically correct.
- On mailed check letters, the greeting is now punctuated with a comma instead of a colon. This is changed on both English and Spanish letters.
- Corrected a bug that prevented the selection of a topic even if it had not been included in the list of topics discussed.
- The Medical Foods window is repositioned to fully display age and adjusted age fields.
- In Preferences, corrected a bug that allowed the user to inadvertently change the wrong item name (handouts, topics, referrals, etc.)

## **ProviderOne (P1)**

### **What's New**

- A ProviderOne search tool was added, which can be used to quickly and accurately assess if a ProviderOne client is on an income-qualifying medical program.
- The ProviderOne search tool consists of a ProviderOne ID field and a [P1 Search] button. Both are located on the Income tab directly below the Proof of Pregnancy Mover Box.
- The ProviderOne search tool can be used on the Income Documentation tab in any wizard that allows you to enter or edit income data.
- A ProviderOne search can be done by entering the 9-digit number from the ProviderOne Services Card into the ProviderOne ID field and clicking the [P1

Search] button. (The WA at the end of the number does not need to be entered.) This will trigger a search for a match in the database and pop up a ProviderOne Search Results screen.

- The ProviderOne Search Results screen can be moved and data can be entered on the Income Documentation tab while the results screen remains open.
- Once the wizard is completed, the ProviderOne ID that was used for the search will be saved in the ProviderOne ID field.
- The ProviderOne ID can be edited and a new search can be done any time during the certification period by opening any wizard that allows you to enter or edit income data.
- The ProviderOne ID can be copied from the ProviderOne ID field by highlighting the number and clicking the right mouse button, or using the [Ctrl+C] and then pasted into other fields by using the [Ctrl+V] keyboard shortcuts.
- The last searched ProviderOne ID will be carried forward to subsequent certifications.
- On the Income Documentation tab in the Certification History and Report, the ProviderOne ID field is view only and the [P1 Search] button is grayed out.
- The label 'Medical Coupon' was replaced with 'Medical Services Card/ProviderOne' in the Proof of Income field and the Proof of ID & Proof of Residency Mover Boxes.
- Any client that previously had 'Medical Coupon' selected in one of these fields now will say 'Medical Services Card/ProviderOne'.
- Medical Services Card/ProviderOne was added as an option to be selected in the Proof of Pregnancy Mover Box.
- The ProviderOne ID will be blank on the Income Documentation tab in the In-State or Out-of-State Transfer In wizard.
  
- The Medicaid, TANF, Basic Food Program and/or FDPIR box on the Income Documentation tab will be blank at the Recertification.
