1	Visit every provider in the county that uses state supplied vaccine at least 1x this calendar year to provide education and training on Child Profile. If providers are not using Child Profile encourage use in some electronic immunization registry.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Continue work with Providers to promote complete entry of immunization data into CHILD Profile. 2. Increase immunization compliance and completion of recommended vaccines in school age populations. 3. Provide on site evaluation to determine best way to integrate CHILD Profile or other electronic registry into provider practice. 4. Provide on site train-the-trainer education for providers using CHILD Profile. 5. Work with providers to identify and/or develop a reminder recall system. 6. Work with DOH Child Profile to overcome barrier to data integration with Practice Partner Electronic Medical Records and on "data dumping."
1	Provide immunization presentations for physicians detailing new vaccines.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Presentations scheduled for providers in the county 2. Provide informational packets distributed to providers unable to attend presentations

2	Standardize internal reporting system and procedures.	1. Review of 2009 CD cases and follow ups. 2. Review of 2009 cases to ensure mandatory fields completed.
2	Conduct an in-house training and case reviews on the procedure for timely and complete case investigation and reporting. Increase internal communication and tracking of CD cases for timely and complete case investigation.	1. Ongoing training for CD Staff on PHIMS reporting procedures. 2. Conduct regular in-house training on the policy for timely and complete case investigation. 3. Training for staff on new reporting requirements and team approach to investigations including biweekly case conferences. 4. Expand internal database and tracking system. 5. Continue bi-annual provider meetings through Region 2 Liaisons to update reporting requirements. 6. Continue quarterly Region 2 newsletters to providers.
