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Performance Measure #1 – Increase the uptake of new and under-used child and adolescent vaccines; specifically focusing improvement efforts and reporting on Varicella, Rota Virus, HPV and pediatric influenza.

Reporting Measure

A: Number of doses of vaccine ordered by each LHJ

B: Number of doses administered as recorded in CHILD Profile

PM#	Objectives / Strategies	Action
1	Assure proper utilization of Child Profile by Lincoln County Providers	Ensure that every provider in the county that uses state supplied vaccine is trained on the use of child profile. This will include the use of the recall system.
1	Increase the uptake of HPV among Male and Female adolescence	Increase awareness of providers around the availability of HPV vaccine. Influence school nurses to include HPV education in the human growth and development curriculum. Increase community advertising to raise community awareness of HPV vaccine.
1	Continue an educational outreach program around underutilized vaccines focusing on DTaP, HPV, Varicella, Rota Virus and Tdap	Place advertisements in local news publications and school handouts.
1	Increase immunization rates of all children birth to 18 years	Review current immunization status for all children coming to the health department for WIC or Immunization services. Provide parents with a written immunization record.

Performance Measure #2 – Improve the timely, complete identification and standard, effective investigation of notifiable conditions per WAC 246-101.

Reporting Measure

A: Percent of notifiable condition cases reported to the LHJ within the required timeframe (per WAC)

B: Percent of notifiable condition cases reported to the LHJ where investigation was initiated within the timeframe specified in the Guidelines

C: Percent of notifiable condition cases reported to the LHJ with a completed investigation as indicated by completion of “essential fields”

PM#	Objectives / Strategies	Action
2	Improve timely notifiable condition reporting by providers	Train healthcare providers on notifiable condition reporting requirements. Educate Medical Assistants on notifiable conditions reporting requirements. Assure providers have 24/7 health department reporting contact information. Provide monthly updates to providers regarding notifiable conditions.
2	Improve timely response to notifiable condition reports by health department staff	Utilize quality improvement strategies to review notifiable conditions tracking procedures to identify gaps and delays in response. Train staff based on identified gaps
2	Increase efficient utilization of phims system	Provide phims training to health department staff to efficiently utilize the tool.
2	Utilize current epidemiology and disease investigation protocols	Review and update Health Department communicable disease response manual and provide training to staff.

Performance Measure #3 – Develop and implement effective community and health care system interventions to address obesity and its consequent burden of chronic disease. Interventions may target worksites, schools, communities, or primary medical care.

Reporting Measure

A: Number and description of LHJ activities and interventions to address obesity or chronic disease and association risk factors in the community.

PM#	Activity	Action
3	Track Lincoln County trends with childhood obesity compared to National Standards	Collect height, weight, and age measurements for every school district in Lincoln County for K-7 th grade to compare local BMI and obesity rates with national rates.
3	Develop school based healthy living campaign at Reardan School District.	Partner with Reardan School District and Lincoln Hospital District 1 to develop and implement a school based healthy living campaign to improve healthy lifestyles of school aged kids.
3	Provide easier access to fresh fruits and vegetables for Lincoln County residents	Partner with local organizations to establish local farmer markets and a community garden.
