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Performance Measure #1 – Increase the uptake of new and under-used child and adolescent vaccines; specifically focusing improvement efforts and reporting on Varicella, Rota Virus, HPV and pediatric influenza.

A: Number of doses of vaccine ordered by each LHJ

B: Number of doses administered as recorded in CHILD Profile

1	SAMPLE: Visit every provider in the county that uses state supplied vaccine at least 1x this calendar year to provide education and training on CHILD Profile and recruit / improve their participation.	Hire 1 new RN (1FTE)
1	SAMPLE: Work with providers to incorporate the use of the reminder / recall portion of CHILD Profile to increase child vaccine timeliness and administration	Contact providers and help them implement reminder/recall activities.
1	Monitor baseline (current measures) and periodic improvements in vaccine uptake and utilization to recognize trends and tailor activities	Track vaccine orders placed and shipped and doses administered by Vaccine for Children Providers.
1	Work with provider offices to increase the number of doses of vaccine administered and enhance their utilization of the Child Profile Immunization Registry	Provide annual CME trainings for Vaccine for Children Provider offices focusing on activities to improve the delivery and uptake of childhood immunizations including : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work to Increase provider participation in the Child Profile Immunization Registry • Provide training about data quality and cleanup, one dose away, and reminder recall processes • Provide information to individual practices during AFIX and ARRA visits and through quarterly CoCasa reports about strategies to improve uptake and rates. • Promote new vaccines through frequent vaccine updates, web site postings and and Epi Info newsletters
1	Work in partnership with schools and providers offices to improve the number of doses of vaccine administered.	Continue work with local providers to identify and provide options for immunizations for children without access to a provider. Provide info to the public through handouts and web site postings. Work with school nurses and staff to foster the use of the Child Profile system as an adjunct to school records.

2	SAMPLE: Hire additional new staff; send to CD and PHIMs training; familiarize them with 2002 guidelines in PHIM; focus contact investigation and follow-up with every Chlamydia case.	Hire .5 FTE of disease investigator
2	SAMPLE: Conduct an in-house training on the policy for timely and complete case investigation	----
2	Monitor baseline (current measures) and periodic improvements in the timeliness of notifiable conditions reported through the Public Health Issue Management System (PHIMS), the timeliness of staff initiating and completing investigations on these conditions.	Review with staff timeliness reports generated through PHIMS by both our agency and DOH bi-monthly and look for opportunities to improve.
2	Provide information to reporting partners through multiple methods to stress the importance of timely reporting by partners to local health	Distribute information about reporting to partners through: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Epi Info newsletters • CD Updates • Training to PSPH Residency Program • Dr Yu and hospital Grand Rounds • Nurse liaisons • Web site
2	Assure notifiable condition are reported, investigations are initiated, completed and reported to DOH within guidelines.	Identify opportunities to improve the notifiable conditions reporting system (timeliness, completeness) using PDSA Rapid Cycle Improvement strategies. Work toward 100% compliance to affect change in immediately notifiable conditions and 2 – 3 other conditions or attributes of reporting where timeliness and completeness are an issue.

Performance Measure #3 – Develop and implement effective community and health care system interventions to address obesity and its consequent burden of chronic disease. Interventions may target worksites, schools, communities, or primary medical care.

A: Number and description of LHJ activities and interventions to address obesity or chronic disease and association risk factors in the community.
