1	Objective: A public health nurse will deliver education, information and technical assistance/training to each medical provider in the county that uses state supplied vaccine. A minimum of 1 onsite visit to each office will be completed during 2012.	Keep pediatric vaccine providers updated with the latest CDC vaccine recommendations and guidelines.

Performance Measure #2 – Improve the timely, complete identification and standard, effective investigation of notifiable conditions per WAC 246-101.

Reporting Measure

A: Percent of notifiable condition cases reported to the LHJ within the required timeframe (per WAC)

B: Percent of notifiable condition cases reported to the LHJ where investigation was initiated within the timeframe specified in the Guidelines

C: Percent of notifiable condition cases reported to the LHJ with a completed investigation as indicated by completion of “essential fields”

PM#	Objectives / Strategies	Action
2	Public health nurses will receive training on communicable disease updates, TB case investigation, and other related topics in 2012.	Each public health nurse working in communicable disease investigation will attend a minimum of 1 training.
2	Each reported case of chlamydia, gonorrhea and syphilis will be investigated and a contact/partner management plan will be developed, including PDPT and EPT during 2012.	A public health nurse will investigate all reported cases of chlamydia, gonorrhea and syphilis and will ensure that partners receive appropriate prophylaxis.
2	An “Epi News” (communicable disease alert) will be written and distributed to all medical offices when local and state high profile issues occur, such as outbreaks, during 2012.	Blast fax Epi News to all medical offices to keep them informed.

Performance Measure #3 – Develop and implement effective community and health care system interventions to address obesity and its consequent burden of chronic disease. Interventions may target worksites, schools, communities, or primary medical care.

Reporting Measure

A: Number and description of LHJ activities and interventions to address obesity or chronic disease and association risk factors in the community.
