1	Identify providers who have a low rate of use of new and under-used child and adolescent vaccines.	<p>Monitor vaccine usage reports and strategize with providers to increase usage.</p> <p>Nurse Epidemiologist to work with providers in assessing current use and barriers to providing the new and underused vaccines</p> <p>Educate providers on report capabilities/CoCasa of CHILD Profile to run practice specific reports on missing immunizations, invalid doses of vaccines and missed opportunities to immunize.</p>
1	Keep providers up-to-date on current immunization recommendations and practices.	<p>Conduct immunization provider education updates biannually.</p> <p>Assure a current email and fax number list of all state supplied vaccine providers to get updates and best practices information out in a timely manner to immunization providers.</p>
1	Provide continuing support/training and updates to providers using CHILD Profile.	Educate new hires in the providers offices of the benefits of CHILD Profile, how to enter data and utilize available reports.
