1	Visit every county provider using state supplied vaccine at least 1x calendar year to provide education, training and the continued support on CHILD Profile to improve their participation and increase their effectiveness in managing their vaccine supplies.	RN - 0.5 FTE Meet with VFC providers to promote their increased usage of Child Profile
1	Continue to work with providers to incorporate the use of the reminder / recall portion of CHILD Profile to increase child vaccine timeliness and administration.	Meet with providers and assist with implementing reminder/recall activities.
1	Increase the provider's awareness of the ACIP's recommendations of current, new and underused pediatric vaccines by providing the most current immunization schedules available.	Meet with every VFC clinic and provide updates to ACIP's recommended immunization schedules annually. Encourage them to offer all vaccines.

2	Promote LHJ staff training and education on communicable diseases to improve their knowledge base of current CD trends increasing their effectiveness and timeliness of investigations.	0.75 FTE of disease investigator
2	Cross train PHNs and EH staff to provide support and assistance during CD investigations.	Ongoing coordination and meetings between PHN and EH staff. Utilize training resources as able
2	Improve timely and complete investigation of reported cases on all CD/reportable conditions.	Staff will audit PHIMS reports on an ongoing basis to ensure all data entered is complete and correct.
2	Educate Klickitat County reporters ie labs, clinics, new providers and hospitals for notifiable conditions and timeframes to increase accuracy and timeliness of reporting.	At least once annually visit with county reporters and partners to provide current CD reportable conditions and requirements.
