Compile data from Child Profile and monthly reports to send out letters.
1	Provide training and technical support to 100% of VFC providers using WAIS who have staff turnover or request extra assistance.	Coordinate trainings with providers who need/request assistance.
1	Conduct ongoing outreach and education to healthcare providers to improve vaccine administration and uptake.	Continue to facilitate and coordinate the Immunization Action Coalition of the Inland Northwest.
1	Support the WAIS staff and DOH consultant in development of HL7 interfaces with the WAIS to increase utilization of the WAIS and to increase doses administered in the WAIS	Act as a provider liaison between WAIS staff and DOH Consultant.
