

Instructions printing the “Public Health and You” brochure

- **Brochure for professional printing:** this file folder is for use if you are going to have the brochure professionally printed. It contains the native artwork files. Give this file to the printer. They can insert your agency copy and logo on the back panel. The brochure is two-color and will need to be printed in the two colors specified in the artwork file. These files are in Freehand 9.0 and you will probably not be able to open them, but any graphic designer or printer should be able to work with them.
- **Brochure for desktop printing:** This file is for your use if you want to do a “quick print” or photocopy of the brochure yourself. The brochure template file is in JPEG format. To use the template, you’ll need to place it in a layout program like PageMaker and then insert your own copy and logo(s) right on top of the existing artwork, which will serve as your background.
