### Women and children served through WIC: **1,483**

- Tracking, testing, and treatment of sexually transmitted diseases, HIV/AIDS, TB, and Hepatitis, to prevent further disease

### Children and adults immunized against infectious diseases: **7,381**

- Vaccine (doses) given to prevent diseases
