### Priority Areas

- Healthy Eating

- Healthy starts for children
- Prevention and mitigation of Adverse Childhood Experiences/toxic stress in families
- Improved clinical-community linkages
- Services and supports that build pathways to better health and improved quality of life that address social determinants of health

## Small Group Break Out Session

### Criteria (to consider in the discussion)

- **Upstream** – the issue has an impact on health by intervening in the causes of poor health, rather than focusing on the health problems themselves
- Addresses those conditions that result in the **greatest morbidity, mortality, disability** and years of productive life lost
- Addressing this issue will **reduce health inequities**
- Impacts are **measurable**
- **Interventions** are currently available
- **Resources** (staff, time, money, equipment) are currently available to solve this problem
- There is **political will** (is the time right?)
- Addresses **cost drivers** that impact poor health
- Addressing this issue now is **cost-effective**
