Performance Management Glossary:

Health Determinants include measures relating to social and economic environment, the physical environment, and the person's individual characteristics and behaviors all of which affect health status over time.

Health Outcomes are long-term measures of health status, levels of disease, injury, or dysfunction, and prevalence of risk factors.

Health Status measures the current state of a specific aspect of health.

Outputs are data about activities. They are the direct results of program activities, described in terms of size and scope of the services or products delivered or produced by the program.

Performance Measures are the specific quantitative representation of capacity, process, or outcome deemed relevant to the assessment of performance. These measures demonstrate results achieved in 1-3 years.
