Cowlitz County: Health advisory ends for Carrolls Water Association

OLYMPIA — A boil-water advisory for the community of Carrolls in southeastern Cowlitz County ended today.

The Department of Health issued the advisory on Wednesday, May 8, after part of the water system lost pressure. When water pressure is lost, contaminants can be drawn into the water lines. The problem was traced to a well pump.

Lab tests on samples collected from the system show the water is safe to drink. Although safe to drink, the Carrolls Water Association is asking customers to conserve water because the system is operating without its main well.
