## **Lewis County: Boil water advisory ends for Mossyrock residents**

**OLYMPIA** — Mossyrock residents can stop boiling their drinking water. The town ended its boil-water advisory today after lab tests showed the water meets safe drinking water standards.

The utility issued an advisory to nearly 600 homes and businesses after a water main broke Monday morning. The break caused a loss in water pressure, which posed a risk that contaminated water could get into the water distribution system.

Utility crews repaired the broken water main, flushed the lines, and took water samples to test for bacterial contamination. Lab results received this afternoon confirm the water is free of potentially harmful bacteria.
