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State disciplines health care providers

OLYMPIA — The Washington State Department of Health has taken disciplinary actions or withdrawn charges against health care providers in our state.

The department's Health Systems Quality Assurance Division works with boards, commissions, and advisory committees to set licensing standards for more than 80 health care professions (e.g., medical doctors, nurses, counselors).

Information about health care providers is on the agency website. Click on "[Look up a healthcare provider license](#)" in the "How Do I?" section of the [Department of Health website](#) (doh.wa.gov). The site includes information about a health care provider's license status, the expiration and renewal date of their credential, disciplinary actions and copies of legal documents issued after July 1998. This information is also available by calling 360-236-4700. Consumers who think a health care provider acted unprofessionally are encouraged to call and report their complaint.

Chelan County

In October 2013 the Nursing Assistant Program reinstated the certified nursing assistant credential of **Jennifer I. McManus** (NC10041336) and placed her on probation for at least one year. In 2011 her credential was suspended for at least two years after she verbally and physically abused a patient.

Clark County

In November 2013 the Nursing Commission reinstated the registered nursing credential of **Linda Weinzimmer-Kirk** (RN00084119) and placed her on probation for 90 days. The commission suspended her credential in 2012 because her chart entries didn't match treatment provided to patients.

King County

In October 2013 the Midwife Program entered an agreement with midwife **Pamela A. Golliet** (MW00000296) that says she must pay a \$3,000 fine and not advertise her services as a midwife unless she has a valid license. Golliet advertised her services as a midwife between January and July 2013; her credential had been suspended in 2012 for at least three years.

In October 2013 the Chemical Dependency Professional Program conditionally granted a chemical dependency professional trainee credential to **David Jacob Kost** (CO60393637) and placed him on probation. Kost must take continuing education in ethics and must undergo evaluation for a substance abuse monitoring program. His registered counselor credential was suspended in 2010 after he didn't comply with an order to undergo a substance abuse evaluation. In 2013 he entered a drug diversion program after being charged with four counts of first-degree trafficking in stolen property.

In October 2013 the Home Care Aide Program conditionally granted a certified home care aide credential to **Frances Michele Tucker** (HM60398717) and ordered her to undergo evaluation for a substance abuse monitoring program. In 2006 Tucker was convicted of theft. In 2008 she was convicted of attempted possession of a controlled substance.

In October 2013 the Nursing Assistant Program charged registered nursing assistant **Jessica DeLeon** (NA00039230) with unprofessional conduct. DeLeon allegedly took money from a resident at a facility where she worked. She hasn't responded to a Department of Health inquiry.

In November 2013 the Psychology Board amended a statement of charges against psychologist **Elizabeth M. Milo** (PY00002526) to add details and to change references about her relationship with patients.

Kitsap County

In October 2013 the Nursing Assistant Program charged registered nursing assistant **Kalee Teresa Wyant** (NA60184619) with unprofessional conduct. While she worked at a long-term care facility, Wyant allegedly took jewelry and/or money valued at about \$10,000 from several residents. Charges say she sold the jewelry at pawn shops. In 2013 she was charged with one count of residential burglary and two counts of first-degree trafficking in stolen property.

Okanogan County

In October 2013 the Nursing Commission charged registered nurse **Ronda Lemmon** (RN00144814) with unprofessional conduct. Lemmon allegedly didn't comply with a previous stipulation.

Pierce County

In October 2013 the Nursing Commission reinstated the licensed practical nursing credential of **Cynthia D. Gates** (LP00052388) and placed her on probation. She must complete a refresher course and undergo evaluation for a substance abuse monitoring program.

In October 2013 the X-Ray Technician Program conditionally granted an X-ray technician credential to **Tracy Ann Powell** (XT60386642), whose certified nursing assistant credential was reinstated in 2013 after being suspended in 2011.

In October 2013 the Nursing Assistant Program ended probation for registered nursing assistant **Alyssa Marie Taylor** (NA60198843).

In October 2013 the Nursing Assistant Program conditionally granted a certified nursing assistant credential to **Maariet Lynn Schmid** (NC60297713) and placed her credential on probation for at least one year. In 2009 she was twice convicted of third-degree theft and first-degree criminal trespass.

In October 2013 the Home Care Aide Program conditionally granted a home care aide credential to **Jazmine Nicole Stanley** (HM60394748) and ordered her to undergo evaluation for a substance abuse monitoring program. In 2011 Stanley received deferred prosecution for driving while intoxicated and for third-degree driving while license suspended.

In November 2013 the Chemical Dependency Professional Program ended probation for chemical dependency professional trainee **Bradley Shane Morton** (CO60285522).

Skagit County

In October 2013 the Chemical Dependency Professional Program conditionally granted a chemical dependency professional trainee credential to **Kealy Marie Marquis** (CO60418964) and placed her on probation. Marquis must continue to comply with a substance abuse monitoring contract mandated under a 2013 decision to conditionally grant her an agency affiliated counselor credential.

Snohomish County

In October 2013 the Radiologic Technologist Program entered an agreement with radiologic technologist **Zoya Migirova**, also known as Zoya Mushailova (RT00008405), and placed her credential on probation for at least three years. In 2013 she was convicted of six counts of mail fraud and five counts of theft of government funds.

Thurston County

In October 2013 the Nursing Commission ended conditions on the credential of registered nurse **Janet Lynn Streuli**, also known as Janet L. Gray (RN00112842).

Whatcom County

In October 2013 the Certified Counselor Program denied a certified counselor credential to **Lindsay M. Cain** (CL60319556), who doesn't meet the educational requirements.

In October 2013 the Dental Commission ended probation for dental assistant **Lucy Ann Kosanke** (D160084640).

Yakima County

In October 2013 the Nursing Commission entered an agreement with licensed practical nurse **Lane M. Willis** (LP00024447) that placed her credential on probation for at least two years. Willis forged physicians' signatures on patients' treatment plans.

Out of State

Arizona: In October 2013 the Nursing Commission reinstated the registered nursing credential of **Ronald Isaboke Mogaka** (RN60196154). Mogaka's credential was suspended in 2012 after his Minnesota credentials were suspended for being behind on child support payments.

California: In October 2013 the Marriage and Family Therapist Program granted a marriage and family therapist associate credential to **Chelsy Jane Bundy** (MG60291954) and ordered her to take continuing education in ethics. Bundy practiced as a marriage and family therapist associate between June 2012 and June 2013 despite having no credential.

California: In October 2013 the Psychology Board denied a temporary permit to practice psychology to **Gary Alan Zink** (TE60116090), who hasn't provided proof of required internship experience.

New York: In October 2013 the Medical Commission charged physician assistant **Kristen A. Gnage** (PA10004830) with unprofessional conduct. In 2012 Gnage entered a stipulation in New York allegedly admitting she issued four blank prescriptions to people who weren't her patients. In 2013 she surrendered her New York license, saying she was severely incapacitated by an eating disorder. She hasn't responded to a Washington investigator's inquiry.

Oregon: In October 2013 the Nursing Commission reinstated the registered nursing credential of **Susan D. Fast** (RN00125856). This reinstatement is based on her completion of requirements imposed by a July 2013 reinstatement order. Her credential was revoked for at least five years in 2008 after she was convicted in Oregon of first-degree theft and aggravated first-degree theft in connection with the theft of more than \$28,900 from her employer.

Oregon: In November 2013 the Nursing Commission denied a licensed practical nursing credential to **Carolyn Lorraine Miller** (LP60334166), who doesn't meet the educational requirements.

Note to Editors: Health care providers charged with unprofessional conduct have 20 days to respond to the Department of Health in writing. The case then enters the settlement process. If no disciplinary agreement can be reached, the case will go to a hearing.
