OLYMPIA – The Washington State Board of Health is accepting nominations for the Warren Featherstone Reid Award from March 13 to May 13. The prestigious award, now in its 20th year, recognizes cost-effective and quality health care services in both an individual and a facility category. It's presented annually by the governor in conjunction with the secretary of health.
