Lewis County EMT's license suspended due to sexual misconduct

OLYMPIA — The Office of Emergency Medical Services and Trauma System Programs has immediately suspended the license of Lewis County Emergency Medical Technician, Richard Lovel Crumbliss (ES60349848) on charges of unprofessional conduct.

Crumbliss has been charged with three felony sex crimes in Lewis County Superior Court.

He has 20 days to respond to the charges and request a hearing, and cannot practice as an emergency medical technician until these charges are resolved.
