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State revokes, suspends licenses, certifications, registrations of health care providers

OLYMPIA — The Washington State Department of Health has revoked or suspended the licenses, certifications, or registrations of health care providers in our state. The department has also immediately suspended the credentials of people who have been prohibited from practicing in other states.

The department's Health Systems Quality Assurance Division works with boards, commissions and advisory committees to set licensing standards for more than 80 health care professions (e.g., medical doctors, nurses, counselors).

Information about health care providers is on the agency's website. Click on "[Look up a healthcare provider license](#)" in the "How Do I?" section of the [Department of Health home page](#) (doh.wa.gov). The site includes information about a health care provider's license status, the expiration and renewal date of their credential, disciplinary actions and copies of legal documents issued after July 1998. This information is also available by calling 360-236-4700.

Consumers who think a health care provider acted unprofessionally are also encouraged to call and report their complaint.

Chelan County

In January 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of registered nursing assistant **Dylan Dean Farley** (NA60324410) for at least two years. Farley showed up to work drunk while employed at an adult family home.

In January 2014 the Department of Health indefinitely suspended the credential of certified nursing assistant **Dulce Ibarra** (NC60014795) for not completing required continuing education.

Clallam County

In March 2014 the secretary of health indefinitely suspended the credential of registered nursing assistant **Michelle Madona Kinsman** (NA00176365). She was seen smoking marijuana with a

patient and talking about swapping medications. Kinsman later failed a drug test, testing positive for methadone.

Clark County

In January 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of massage practitioner **Patrick J. Sellem** (MA60284842) for at least five years. Sellem pled guilty to two counts of voyeurism, second-degree criminal trespassing, and violating a civil anti-harassment protection order.

Cowlitz County

In February 2014 the Nursing Commission immediately suspended the credential of registered nurse **Daniel K. Stoneking** (RN00172588). His license was revoked by the Texas Board of Nursing because he was denied a license in California for stealing and using drugs.

Franklin County

In January 2014 the Medical Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of physician and surgeon **John C. Perry** (MD00025747). He was evaluated by a psychiatrist and deemed unable to practice due to an untreated severe narcissistic personality disorder.

King County

In January 2014 the Dental Commission fined and mandated continuing education for dentist **Betsy Rocio Mosquera** (DE00009746). She made a mistake during a root form implant procedure.

In January 2014 the Medical Commission accepted the surrendered license of physician and surgeon **Timothy J. Smith** (MD00018800). He was seen smoking meth and had meth, glass pipes, and marijuana in his house.

In March 2014 the secretary of health indefinitely suspended the credential of registered and certified nursing assistant **Rean Tenero Unida** (NA60243196 and NC60274835). While working at a nursing home, Unida didn't immediately report an incident when a resident fell and sustained a fracture. Unida later made a false report about what happened.

In March 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of registered nursing assistant **Harmony C. Austin** (NA00120570) for at least five years for exploiting a vulnerable adult while working as a caregiver. Austin took \$3,000-to-\$3,700 from a patient for personal use.

Okanogan County

In January 2014 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of registered nurse **April Ann Carden** (RN00155917). She didn't enroll into a drug and alcohol monitoring program after being convicted of fourth-degree assault, driving while intoxicated, using drug paraphernalia, and resisting arrest.

Skagit County

In January 2014 the Department of Health permanently revoked the credential of emergency medical technician **Timothy L. Alvord** (ES01175007). He was convicted of one count of second-degree assault domestic violence and two counts of violation of a no contact order. Alvord strangled and threatened to kill the mother of his children with a knife and shotgun.

Spokane County

In December 2013 the Department of Health denied the certified nursing application of **Marcus Kelsey** (NA60323626). In 2006 he was convicted of eight felonies and didn't disclose them on his application.

In February 2014 the secretary of health accepted the surrendered credential of mental health counselor **Candace P. Camp** (LH00005536) after she had an improper personal and sexual relationship with a patient.

In February 2014 the Department of Health indefinitely suspended the credential of registered nursing assistant **Shannon Marie McKinney** (NA60309472) for not enrolling in a required drug and alcohol monitoring program.

In February 2014 the secretary of health withdrew charges against midwife **Elizabeth Morrill** (MW00000229).

In March 2014 the secretary of health issued a permanent cease and desist order to **Irene K. De Villiers**. Though she has no veterinary license, Villiers maintained a website that offered veterinary advice and took money to treat a cat.

Thurston County

In January 2014 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of registered nurse **Amanda M. Liberty** (RN00163459). She didn't account for the wasting or administration of medication for several patients.

In January 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of certified nursing assistant **Kerri Koch** (NC10029326) for at least 10 years. Koch was convicted of first-degree theft with aggravating circumstances and one count of first-degree trafficking stolen property. The convictions were in connection with Koch stealing more than \$5,000 worth of property from a vulnerable adult who was a patient under her care.

In March 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of registered and certified nursing assistant **Terri L. Jadin** (NA60099691 and NC60276755) for at least three years. While working at Rosemount Retirement and Assisted Living Facility, Jadin stole a computer and personal belongings from a resident who died.

In February 2014 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of licensed practical nurse **Dora Jean Leblanc** (LP00055043) by failing the terms of her drug and alcohol monitoring contract. Leblanc tested positive for alcohol.

Walla Walla County

In February 2014 the Nursing Commission accepted the surrendered credential of registered nurse **Carrie C. Daudt** (RN00079726) after she withdrew from a required drug and alcohol monitoring program.

Out of State

Alabama: In February 2014 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of registered nurse **Terrelynn Huston** (RN60265983). Her license was suspended by the California Nursing Board for diverting drugs while she worked at a hospital in Fresno.

California: In January 2014 the Nursing Commission placed registered nurse **Beverly A. Richards** (RN00130158) on probation for three years. Richards' license was revoked in California for not complying with a previous disciplinary order from the state's nursing board.

California: In February 2014 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of registered nurse **Beverly A. Richards** (RN00130158) after her license was revoked in California for failing to comply with the terms of her probation.

Oregon: In January 2014 the Nursing Commission immediately suspended the credential of registered nurse **Laura Faye Dunn** (RN60027850). Her license was revoked in Oregon for diverting oxycodone and she was convicted of perjury, possession of methamphetamine, possession of marijuana, possession of heroin, and endangering the welfare of a minor.

Texas: In March 2014 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of registered nurse **Joseph E. Temko** (RN00073948) for not providing proof that he took a mandatory refresher course as part of his probation.
