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State revokes, suspends licenses, certifications, registrations of health care providers

OLYMPIA — The Washington State Department of Health has revoked or suspended the licenses, certifications, or registrations of health care providers in our state. The department has also immediately suspended the credentials of people who have been prohibited from practicing in other states.

The department's Health Systems Quality Assurance Division works with boards, commissions and advisory committees to set licensing standards for more than 70 health care professions (e.g., medical doctors, nurses, counselors).

Information about health care providers is on the agency's website. Click on "[Look up a healthcare provider license](#)" in the "How Do I?" section of the [Department of Health home page](#) (www.doh.wa.gov). The site includes information about a health care provider's license status, the expiration and renewal date of their credential, disciplinary actions and copies of legal documents issued after July 1998. This information is also available by calling 360-236-4700. Consumers who think a health care provider acted unprofessionally are also encouraged to call and report their complaint.

Clallam County

In March 2014 the secretary of health indefinitely suspended the credential of paramedic **Paul M. Rynearson** (ES00106508). He didn't comply with the terms and conditions of a 2013 agreed order requiring him to submit an evaluation report on his mental health and physical status and treatment prognosis. He also terminated a monitoring program without permission.

Clark County

In June 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of nursing assistant **David S. Meeks** (NC10095355) for at least five years. He admitted to having sexual relations with a client while employed as an in-home care giver for Addus Health Care.

In May 2014 the secretary of health charged nursing assistant **Teresa Marie Meyer** (NC60285192) with unprofessional conduct. Meyer allegedly stole medication from a resident at Glenwood Place Senior Living on at least two separate occasions. The Department of Social and

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Health Services found that Meyer financially exploited a vulnerable adult. Meyer's nursing assistant credential is suspended pending resolution of these charges.

In May 2014 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of registered nurse **Paulus R. Kutrich** (RN00169953). He tested positive for cannabinoids during a drug screen and later admitted to diverting several controlled substances for personal use. Kutrich entered a drug monitoring program and didn't maintain compliance.

Franklin County

In February 2014 the Nursing Commission suspended the credential of registered nurse **Tamira J. Junt** (RN00174176) indefinitely. Junt didn't comply with requirements of an agreed order that reinstated her license provided she submit quarterly personal reports, performance evaluations, and proof of continuing education courses.

In June 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of nursing assistant **Brandi Michelle Nelson** (NC10080670) for at least five years. Nelson was convicted of possessing stolen property and obtaining a controlled substance by forging a prescription.

In May 2014 the secretary of health indefinitely suspended the credential of nursing assistant **Danielle L. Delisle** (NA60394620). She tested positive for amphetamines after being involved in a traffic collision while transporting a patient. Delisle later admitted to using ecstasy.

In April 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of nursing assistant **Elizabeth Nahleen Messinger** (NA60020561) for at least five years. She admitted to accepting \$500 from a resident in her care while employed at Canyon Lakes Adult Family Home.

King County

In March 2014 the Pharmacy Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of pharmacy assistant **Mario P. Beall** (VB60195560). Beall didn't to comply with a 2013 agreement with the commission. He tested positive for marijuana in his initial assessment and didn't continue with any further assessments.

In April 2014 the secretary of health denied a nursing assistant credential to **Tamiko Lanai Glover** (NA60411719). In 2006 Glover was convicted of first degree theft and ordered to pay restitution in the amount of \$51,416.22.

In May 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of nursing assistant **Teresita Cayanan Bautista** (NA60196528) for at least five years. Bautista didn't call for emergency services when helping a patient that was choking. Failure to call 911 may have contributed to the patient's death.

In April 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of massage practitioner **Dwaine Jeffrey Breed** (MA60116962) for at least three years and placed his credential on probation for at least five years. Breed touched a patient's genitals during a massage and then viewed patient's exposed genitals. He was convicted of two counts of voyeurism, a class C felony.

In April 2014 the Nursing Commission entered an order of oversight for registered nurse **Forson Addae-Boateng** (RN00162766). If Addae-Boateng chooses to operate a nursing assistant-certified training program he must have a preapproved advisor for the first year of operation of the training program.

In April 2014 the secretary of health indefinitely suspended the credential of nursing assistant **Daniel Haistings** (NA00180687). He admitted to his supervisor that he falsified a medication record, misrepresented who gave the medication, and that the medication had been given at all.

In April 2014 the secretary of health suspended the credential of nursing assistant **Antonio Music** (NA00132359) for at least five years. Music was charged with six counts of first degree criminal mistreatment, six counts of second degree abandonment of dependent persons, and six counts of reckless endangerment. He admitted to abandoning six clients at an adult family home that he owned and operated.

In March 2014 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of registered nurse **Collette Marie Michaud** (RN60355332). In June 2013 Michaud's nursing credentials were suspended by the Minnesota Board of Nursing for failure to comply with a prior consent order.

In April 2014 the Medical Commission lifted the suspension of physician and surgeon **Myles Ellis Goldflies** (MD00046009) and put his license on probation for at least one year. During his probation, Goldflies can only perform surgeries on patients who've had a pre-operative evaluation done by another board-certified plastic surgeon. An advisor will monitor his practice and ensure compliance with an evaluation of patient charts, medical records, appointment logs, and interviews. Goldflies will submit a report describing the appropriate evaluation of a patient for plastic surgery and allow a commission representative to make annual visits to conduct practice reviews. A fine of \$1,000 will also be paid to the commission.

In March 2014 the secretary of health indefinitely suspended the credentials of chemical dependency professional trainee **Tanya L. Mathews** (CO60329815). She didn't comply with a monitoring contract. Mathews stopped checking in, missed two drug tests, and didn't respond to numerous phone calls and a letter.

In April 2014 the Nursing Commission suspended the credential of registered nurse **Shaun J. Richardson** (RN00131344). Richardson didn't comply with a 2009 monitoring contract, missed required check-ins, and relapsed on alcohol in December 2013.

In April 2014 the Pharmacy Commission indefinitely suspended the credential of pharmacy technician **Candis R. Wade** (VA00049261), who hasn't complied with a 2011 agreement to reimburse the commission \$1,000 within two years of the order.

Kitsap County

In June 2014 the secretary of health immediately suspended the credential of home care aide **Jessica Ann Bogan** (HM60313120) pending further legal action on to charges of financial exploitation of a vulnerable adult. Bogan allegedly admitted to taking belongings from a client without permission while working in the client's home.

Okanogan County

In June 2014 Social Worker Program charged licensed social worker **Debra Van Brunt-Oreiro** (LW00006875) with unprofessional conduct. Brunt-Oreiro pled guilty to making and submitting a false income tax return while she was the owner and primary medical provider at ADJR Counseling Services.

Pierce County

In June 2014 the Medical Commission suspended the license of physician and surgeon **Gregory Brammer** (MD00037500) for at least five years. Brammer was convicted of harassment/bodily injury against his wife in August 2011. Brammer allegedly punched her in the face, slapped her with an open hand, strangled her, held her to the ground, and squeezed her hands together. Before being able to petition for reinstatement of his license, he must complete a behavioral evaluation, provide an endorsement from the Washington Physicians Health Program, comply with a 2013 Texas Medical Board Order, and fulfill his criminal sentence.

Whatcom County

In May 2014 the secretary of health permanently revoked the credential of x-ray technician **Jennifer Lynn Wolford** (XT00005315). Wolford was convicted of three counts of second degree theft and one count of first degree theft. She received more than \$64,000 in disability claims that she wasn't entitled to after forging a physician's signature on multiple occasions.

In June 2014 the Pharmacy Commission suspended the credential of pharmacy technician **Tammy P. Jacobson** (VA00013093) for at least five years. Jacobson admitted to diverting drugs for personal use while employed at a pharmacy over a six-year period and stealing money on multiple occasions.
