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Dentist in Thurston County surrenders license after initial suspension

OLYMPIA — The state Dental Quality Assurance Commission accepted the license surrender of Lacey dentist Sherilyn Malloy (DENT.00006693). She is unable to practice with reasonable skill and safety due to a mental or physical condition.

In September of 2014 the commission suspended Malloy pending an assessment of her ability to practice safely. Malloy also faced charges of unprofessional conduct including failing to meet the standard of care, inadequate record keeping, and not complying with a discipline order.

The surrender of Malloy's license resolves this case.
