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State revokes, suspends licenses, certifications, registrations of health care providers

OLYMPIA — The Washington State Department of Health has revoked or suspended the licenses, certifications, or registrations of health care providers in our state. The department has also immediately suspended the credentials of people who have been prohibited from practicing in other states.

The department's Health Systems Quality Assurance Division works with boards, commissions and advisory committees to set licensing standards for more than 80 health care professions (e.g., medical doctors, nurses, counselors).

Information about health care providers is on the agency's website. Click on "[Look up a health care provider license](#)" in the "How Do I?" section of the [Department of Health home page](#) (www.doh.wa.gov). The site includes information about a health care provider's license status, the expiration and renewal date of their credential, disciplinary actions and copies of legal documents issued after July 1998. This information is also available by calling 360-236-4700. Consumers who think a health care provider acted unprofessionally are also encouraged to call and report their complaint.

Clark County

In December 2014 the Home Care Aide Program indefinitely suspended the home care aide credential of **Nicole Maureen Mallars** (HM60433762), who didn't comply with a substance abuse monitoring contract.

In January 2015 the secretary of health suspended for at least five years the registered nursing assistant credential of **Kathleen Jean Conner** (NA60436775). While working at an adult family home, Conner committed several thefts from other employees and from a resident.

King County

In January 2015 the secretary of health indefinitely suspended the registered nursing assistant credential of **Mawa Conde** (NA60101258). Conde worked at an adult family home where she found a patient who had fallen on the floor. Conde put the patient back in bed without knowing whether the patient was injured and without summoning help.

In January 2015 the Chemical Dependency Professional Program indefinitely suspended the chemical dependency professional trainee credential of **Dustin William Doerflinger** (CO60166504), who didn't comply with a substance abuse monitoring contract.

In January 2015 the Unlicensed Practice Program ordered **Gang Wang** to cease and desist from the practice of reflexology, and to pay a \$1,000 fine. Wang, who doesn't have a reflexology certificate, performed foot massage on a client.

In January 2015 the Massage Practitioner Program entered into an agreement with massage practitioner **Johnny L. McCree** (MA00023397) under which he surrendered his license. McCree kissed, touched, and caressed a client in a sexual manner.

In January 2015 the Nursing Assistant Program entered into an agreement with registered nursing assistant **Raquel Rona Kenagy** (NA60451636) that suspends her credential for at least two years. Kenagy admitted that while working at an assisted living facility, she stole a resident's jewelry and took it to a pawn shop.

In January 2015 the secretary of health suspended for at least two years the registered nursing assistant credential of **Barbara J. Sanjurjo-Manso** (NA00159432). Sanjurjo-Manso took \$14.87 from a patient at a facility where she worked. The Washington State Department of Social and Health Services found she financially exploited a vulnerable adult, and barred her from being employed in caring for and having unsupervised access to vulnerable adults.

Kitsap County

In January 2015 the Pharmacy Commission entered into an agreement with pharmacy assistant **Daniel A. Reyes** (VB00045386) that permanently revokes his credential. In 2014 Reyes was convicted of one count of indecent liberties, five counts of second-degree dealing in depiction of a minor engaged in sexually explicit conduct, one count of sexual exploitation of a minor, one count of communication with a minor for immoral purposes, 10 counts of voyeurism, and seven counts of second-degree possession of depictions of minor engaged in sexually explicit conduct.

Okanogan County

In January 2015 the secretary of health suspended for at least one year the home care aide credential of **Jacki Rae Tasker** (HM60334877). In 2013 she was convicted of driving while intoxicated. Tasker worked at a skilled nursing and assisted living facility. She didn't follow procedures on giving medication to patients, didn't report for a drug test to which she'd agreed, and didn't respond to a Department of Health investigator's inquiry.

Pierce County

In January 2015 the secretary of health suspended for at least five years the registered nursing assistant credential of **Kareema Mariah Wright** (NA60373204). In 2014 Wright was charged with second-degree identity theft and second-degree attempted theft in connection with taking

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and attempting to cash a patient's personal check. She didn't appear for trial, nor did she respond to a statement of charges from the Department of Health.

In January 2015 the Nursing Assistant Program entered into an agreement with certified nursing assistant **Jennifer Michelle Olson** (NC10076528) that suspends her credential for at least two years. Olson admitted taking a bag containing \$1,082 from a patient at a hospital where she worked.

In January 2015 the secretary of health suspended for at least two years the certified nursing assistant credential of **Erika Griselda Martinez** (NC60332213). She falsified her time sheets while providing in-home care and nursing services to a vulnerable adult.

In January 2015 the secretary of health suspended for at least five years the registered nursing assistant credential of **Latrice D. McCleandon** (NA60122157). McCleandon worked at an adult family home that housed a paranoid schizophrenia patient. McCleandon opened a bank account with the patient's Social Security number and had her paychecks deposited into the account.

In January 2015 the Psychology Board entered into an agreement with psychologist **Allen Wayne Traywick** (PY00000657) under which he voluntarily surrendered his credential. Traywick produced reports that didn't comply with requirements on two clients.

Thurston County

In January 2015 the Respiratory Care Practitioner Program entered into an agreement with respiratory care practitioner **Alva George Abrams** (LR00000500) under which he surrendered his license. In 2014 Abrams was convicted of third-degree assault – domestic violence.

In January 2015 the secretary of health suspended for at least five years the certified nursing assistant credential of **Lenell David Washington** (NC10039033). While working at a skilled nursing facility, Washington touched a vulnerable adult patient's breast from outside her clothing, pinched her nipple, and asked her not to report the incident.

In January 2015 the Nursing Commission charged licensed practical nurse **Carolyn Rhaye Brown** (LP60278957) with unprofessional conduct and immediately suspended her license because she is prohibited from practicing nursing in another state. The California Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians revoked Brown's license to practice in that state after it found she didn't safeguard a patient's health and safety. Brown has requested a hearing to contest the charges.

In January 2015 the Medical Commission withdrew a statement of charges against physician **Leonard H. Albert** (MD00015840). Albert permanently surrendered his medical license in December 2014. Albert has retired and is ineligible to return to the practice of medicine in WA.

In January 2015 the Medical Commission withdrew a statement of charges against physician assistant **Larry G. Malcolm** (PA10002342). Malcolm permanently surrendered his medical

license in January 2015. Malcolm has retired and is ineligible to return to the practice of medicine in WA.

Whatcom County

In January 2015 the secretary of health indefinitely suspended the emergency medical technician credential of **Charles Michael Lester** (ES01163649). In 2012 Lester was convicted of second-degree theft. He didn't respond to charges after he applied to reactivate his expired license.

Yakima County

In January 2015 the Unlicensed Practice Program entered into an agreement with **Ramiro P. Arias** that requires him to cease and desist from the practice of massage, and to pay a \$100 fine. Arias doesn't have a massage license, but provided massage services to a client for a fee.

Out of State

Arizona: In December 2014 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the licensed practical nurse credential of **Jonathan Chase Coventry** (LP60311716). He didn't respond to a statement of charges after he surrendered his Arizona license in connection with a pattern of substance abuse.

California: In January 2015 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the registered nurse credential of **Brandyn Moya Salem** (RN60018914). Salem didn't respond to a statement of charges after her Minnesota license was suspended in connection with diverting narcotics.

California: In January 2015 the Nursing Commission indefinitely suspended the registered nurse credential of **Casey M. St. Martin** (RN00172440), whose Idaho license was revoked.

Maine: In December 2014 the Nursing Commission charged registered nurse **Nicolle Dauphinee** (RN60262661) with unprofessional conduct and immediately suspended her license. She didn't respond to the charges, and the commission indefinitely suspended her license in February 2015. Dauphinee surrendered her Maine license in connection with a finding that she diverted narcotics from her employer.
