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## **Snohomish County physician agrees not to practice due to a mental condition**

**OLYMPIA** – Mukilteo physician Eric Haas (MD60064104) has agreed not to practice until a statement of charges issued by the Medical Quality Assurance Commission is resolved. The charges allege that Haas is unable to practice with reasonable skill and safety because of a mental condition.

Haas agreed to interim terms and conditions designed to protect the public without an immediate suspension of his license. Haas may still admit or deny allegations in the charging documents. He has 20 days from the date of the commission's issuance of charges to respond and request a hearing.
