BEGINNING OF REVIEW

A Certificate of Need application has been submitted to the Department of Health by Olympic Peninsula Kidney Center proposing to establish a 4-station dialysis facility in Kitsap County under the provisions of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 70.38.

Description of Proposal: Establish a CN approved dialysis facility in Kitsap County

Estimated Costs: \$542,580

Public Hearing: No public hearing will be held unless requested. To request a hearing, the request must be in writing and include the name, address, and signature of the person making the request. Deadline for requesting a public hearing is 5:00 p.m. on **June 4, 2012**. Faxed requests will not be accepted.

If a public hearing is scheduled, the hearing notice will be published in the Kitsap Sun at least 15 days before the date of the hearing.

Public Comment Period: If no public hearing is held, written comments must be received by the Certificate of Need Program by 5:00 pm, June 22, 2012. Faxed comments will not be accepted.
