DaVita Healthcare Partners is proposing to add 9 stations to Tacoma Dialysis Center located at 3401 South 19th Street in Tacoma, within the Pierce 4 Dialysis Planning Area.

DaVita Healthcare Partners is proposing to establish a new 9-station kidney dialysis facility located at 5306 Pacific Highway East #D in Fife within the Pierce 4 Dialysis Planning Area.

Franciscan Health System is proposing to add 9 stations to St. Joseph Dialysis Center located at 1717 South J Street in Tacoma within the Pierce 1 Dialysis Planning Area.
