NOTICE OF RECRUITMENT

The Department of Health is accepting applications to fill one board member vacancy on the Examining Board of Psychology (board). This is an exciting opportunity for someone willing to study the issues and to make decisions in the public's best interest.

As a member of the board, you will deal with topics that protect the public and ensure the integrity of the profession. State law requires that members be a resident of the state. It also sets various criteria to encourage representation of psychologists and the public.

We recognize the value of diversity in serving the people of Washington. We encourage candidates to apply from areas of the state without current representation, as well as those with varied backgrounds.

The board meets in person about every six weeks on Fridays. The primary responsibilities of the board are:

- Reviewing applicants' qualifications for licensure.
- Reviewing complaints and assisting in disciplinary cases.
- Determining which states and countries have educational and examination licensing requirements equivalent to Washington's.
- Adopting rules subject to the approval of the secretary of the Department of Health.
