In accordance with WAC 246-310-080, Proliance Surgeons, Inc. (DBA Proliance Highlands Surgery Center) is submitting this letter of intent to convert the Proliance Highlands Surgery Center, our existing exempt free standing three operating room ambulatory surgery center located at 510 8th Avenue NE, Suite 100, Issaquah Washington, 98029 to a Certificate of Need approved facility.

Proliance Highlands Surgery Center has been operating as a 3 room exempt center since 2009 and will complete an addition of a 4th room early this summer. We are requesting Certificate of Need certification on all four rooms to continue addressing the growing needs of our patients and provide other surgeons and their patients in this growing region access to a low cost, high quality outpatient surgical setting.

The approximate capital cost of the 4th room will be \$825,000, inclusive of the application fee.
