

Notice of Recruitment

The Department of Health (department) is recruiting to fill four positions on the Certified Counselors and Hypnotherapy Advisory Committee. The department is seeking one certified counselor or certified adviser, one hypnotherapist, and two public members.

The department is looking to appoint people who reflect the diversity of Washington's population and who provide geographic representation from throughout the state. The secretary of health appoints all members.

To qualify, applicants:

- Must be residents of Washington State.
- May not hold an office in a professional association for their profession.
- May not be employed by Washington State.
- Must have been actively engaged in their profession for at least five years immediately preceding appointment.
- Public members must represent the general public and be unaffiliated directly or indirectly with the professions credentialed under chapter 18.19 RCW.

The committee will meet about four times yearly. It will meet at the department's office in Tumwater. Members are paid \$50 per day, and are reimbursed for travel expenses and meals.

If you or someone you know is interested in applying for a position, please complete an application and return it by February 23, 2015, along with a current résumé, and a cover letter of interest.
