



## Notice of Recruitment

The Department of Health (department) is recruiting to fill two positions on the Certified Counselors and Hypnotherapist Advisory Committee. The department is seeking two public members.

The department is looking to appoint people who reflect the diversity of Washington's population and who provide geographic representation from throughout the state. The secretary of health appoints all members.

To qualify, applicants:

- Must be residents of Washington State.
- May not hold an office in a professional association for their profession.
- May not be employed by Washington State.
- Public members must represent the general public and be unaffiliated directly or indirectly with the professions credentialed under chapter 18.19 RCW.

The committee will meet about four times yearly. It will meet at the department's office in Tumwater. Members are paid \$50 per day, and are reimbursed for travel expenses and meals.
