1. A Description of the Extent of Services Proposed:

NKC proposes to add 3 stations to NKC Enumclaw Kidney Center.

2. Estimated Cost of the Proposed Project:

The expansion will be accomplished through the existing built space. NKC understands that the Certificate of Need Program requires an allocation of previously incurred construction costs. The capital expenditure for this project is estimated at \$576,698 and includes an allocation of historical construction costs as well as new equipment costs. The allocated costs were calculated on a cost per station basis per the request of the Certificate of Need Program.

3. Description of the Service Area:
