In accordance with WAC 246-310-080, Eastside Endoscopy Center, LLC ("EEC") hereby submits a letter of intent proposing to establish a new ambulatory surgery center in Bellevue. EEC's Bellevue endoscopy center has historically operated as a certificate of need approved center subject to certain limiting conditions, including the following:

The use of the facility is limited to physicians who practice as members or employees of Overlake Internal Medical Associates or Northwest Gastroenterology Associates, and are not members or employees of any other individual practice or group practice.

Consistent with the purpose of chapter 70.38 RCW, EEC seeks to have the foregoing limiting condition, which is no longer valid, removed.

2. Estimated Cost of the Proposed Project


The estimated capital expenditure associated with this project is \$0.
