Section 5

- What should a Department of Health approved medical assistant (MA) training program consist of?
- Which examination(s) should be approved for medical assistants-certified?

Section 6

- What minimum standards should be met for a MA-certified to administer intravenous injections for diagnostic or therapeutic agents?
