



## Reproductive Services #1066

**Policy: It is the policy of Confluence Health to provide a guideline for which reproductive services are provided at Confluence Health organizations of Central Washington Hospital and Clinics and Wenatchee Valley Hospital and Clinics.**

### 1. PROCEDURE STATEMENT

- A. Confluence Health provides services for the care of patients who need Obstetrical and Gynecological care. All patients will receive care based upon their individual needs.
- B. Services provided include the following, but is not limited to;
  - a. Routine and high-risk obstetrical care
  - b. In-patient obstetrical care
  - c. Vaginal birth
  - d. Cesarean birth
  - e. Preconception counseling
  - f. Infertility therapy counseling and therapy
  - g. Vaginal reparative surgery
  - h. Incontinence procedures
  - i. Laparoscopic surgery
  - j. General adult and adolescent gynecological care
  - k. Natural and traditional menopausal care
2. Contraception Counseling
3. Management of Premenstrual Syndrome (PMS) and Premenstrual Dysphoric Disorder (MPDD)
4. Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) screening and treatment
5. BRCA genetic testing (BRCA1 and BRCA2 assesses if a woman has an increased risk of developing breast and ovarian cancer)
6. COLARIS genetic testing (assesses a woman's risk of developing hereditary uterine cancer)
7. Termination of pregnancy if deemed medically necessary
  - A. C. As per State Statute, Confluence Health does not mandate that any provider or staff member participate in the termination of a pregnancy that is deemed medically necessary. Only those providers and staff who are willing to participate should do so.
