Re: Letter of Intent for 60 New Acute Care Beds


Dear Ms. Sigman:

In accordance with WAC 246-310-080, King County Public Hospital District #1, Valley Medical Center (VMC) hereby submits a letter of intent proposing to add 60 new acute care beds to the hospital. In conformance with the requirements of WAC, the following information is provided:

1. A Description of the Extent of Services Proposed:  
VMC proposes to add 60 beds. Upon project completion, VMC will be licensed for 363 beds.
2. Estimated Cost of the Proposed Project:  
The capital expenditure associated with this project is estimated at \$20 million.
3. Description of the Service Area:  
According to the Department's acute care bed need methodology, the appropriate service area is the Southeast King County Hospital planning area.
