**PURPOSE STATEMENT**

Clarification of WAC 246-922-040 Examinations.

**POLICY**

For the purposes of accepting National Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners scores, the board considers the passing score to be a single score of Pass/Fail for the Part I examination taken July 1993 or after and March 1995. The board also considers Part II examination as indicated on the test results by National Boards. Prior to the dates designated above for the Part I and II examinations all subjects shall include a "pass" not just a "pass" overall.

Score results prior to July 1993 for Part I and March 1995 for Part II shall be screened to indicate a "pass" on all subjects as well as an overall "pass". A "Pass" overall for each part shall be acceptable for scores after those dates.
