

**The Department of Health will be hosting a webinar on

Substitute House Bill [1737](#) (2013) requires the Medical Quality Assurance Commission (commission) and the Board of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery (board) to work in collaboration with a statewide organization representing the interests of physician assistants to modernize the current physician assistant rules. We will be gathering comments from interested stakeholders during this webinar so that we may continue the process of developing these rules.
