**I. Welcome and objective for the day**

**II. Review and approve of July 25, 2013 meeting minutes**

- a. Approved by the CT Advisory Committee; no changes to be made.

**III. Review draft rule language and issue submittal forms**

**a. Protocol Review (WAC 246-226-050)**

- i. Issue Submittal Form Presentation (Bart Thompson)
  - 1. The CT Advisory Committee agrees to change protocol review from 6 months to 12 months.
  - 2. Vicki Bouvier is leaving all other items open for discussion

**b. Personnel Qualifications (WAC 246-226-080)**

- i. Issue Submittal Form Presentation (Bart Thompson and Vergil Cabasco)
  1. Vicki Bouvier met with Attorney General for the Division of Environmental Public Health who confirmed that under Title 18, we cannot require continuing education although we do have the authority to require Post Primary CT certification.
  2. The CT Advisory Committee agreed that RT's should be ARRT certified along with a Post Primary Certification in CT and Radiologists should be required to be licensed. This will be a significant public health benefit for higher standards in CT use.
    - a. Concerns: Smaller or rural areas may have a harder time meeting scanning requirements and if a RT has a certain amount of years of CT experience, will they have the ability to be "grandfathered-in" into to the program as long as they are able to meeting the training/ testing requirements.
  3. The CT Advisory Committee agrees that they will need additional information from the Department of Health on how many RT's are already ARRT certified in Washington State and where they are located. Susan Gragg will retrieve the numbers and present at the next CT Advisory Committee meeting.

**c. Facility Accreditation (WAC 246-226-040)**

- i. Issue Submittal Form Presentation (Bart Thompson)
  1. The CT Advisory Committee agrees upon "requiring" ACR or IAC accreditation and if a facility cannot meet the needs to be accredited, they will then be required to follow the minimum standards of Washington State qualifications.
  2. ACR, IAC, and Joint Commission Crosswalk
    - a. Jonathan Medverd, Vergil Cabasco, and Kalpana Kanal have volunteered to work on the crosswalk between all three accreditations and will work with Mike Odlaug to establish and present the common standards and will be the key players in deciding on appropriate standards to use in rule language.
    - b. The Department of Health can write the rules either to list specific standards or to make the standards vague and flexible as time passes.

**d. Adverse Event Reporting (WAC 246-226-010)**

- i. Issue Submittal Form Presentation (Vergil Cabasco)
  1. Vicki Bouvier met with Attorney General for the Division of Environmental Public Health who confirmed that under RCW 70.89, we do have rights to collect event reporting's, but they will be subject to a public disclosure by the public.
  2. The CT Advisory Committee agrees to remove the existing event definition on draft rule language and define what the Department of Health is "looking for" in a deterministic event. The CT Advisory Committee also agrees to change the name "Root Cause Analysis" to "Investigation".
