<p>Legislative and Rule-making updates</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● ODW is tracking eight bills. We support three of the bills, we're neutral on four bills, and oppose one. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ SB 6589: Concerning a feasibility study to examine whether water storage would provide non-interruptible water resources to user of permit exempt wells. This bill passed the Senate, now in House. ODW supports this bill. ■ SHB 2357: Concerning the Authority of the Pollution Liability Insurance Agency. This bill has passed both the House and Senate, and awaiting the Signature of the Governor. ODW is supporting this bill. ■ HB 2856: Establishing the Office of Chehalis River Basin Flood Risk Reduction. This bill has passed the House and is in the Senate. ODW is neutral on this bill. ■ 2SHB 2061: Group B Water systems. This bill has passed both the House and the Senate and waiting the Signature of the Governor. ODW opposes this bill. ■ SB 5251: Transfer of DWSRF loan administration from Commerce to DOH. This bill has passed both the House

ODW supports this bill.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ SSB 6284: Preventing water-sewer districts from prohibiting multipurpose fire sprinkler systems. This bill has passed both the House and Senate and is waiting for the Governor's Signature. ODW is neutral on this bill. ▪ SB 6513: Concerning Reservations of Water. This bill has passed both the House and Senate and is waiting for the Governor's Signature. ODW is neutral on this bill. ▪ SB 6179: Concerning Water Banking. This bill has passed both the House and the Senate and is waiting on the Governor's Signature. ODW is neutral on this bill.
