#### 2013 Inland Sampling Site List (weekly sampling July\*-September):

1. Dabob Bay – Rock Point Beach in Tarboo Bay
2. East North Bay – Taylor beach in Victor

5. Hood Canal 3 – Hama Hama site

#### 2013 Coastal Sampling Site List (monthly sampling July and August):

1. Bay Center – Nesbit
2. Grays Harbor – Brady's
3. Nahcotta – North of Nahcotta's boat basin near the Taylor hatchery

#### Sampling site set-up:

- Data logger deployed at each site
- Industry contact for each site (see attached)
  - o Ensure meeting of contact and interns at start of season
- Sampling site identified with PVC pipe (2 – 1" PVC pipes in the ground, leaving about 2 feet of pipe exposed)

#### Lab capacity/research study needs:

- Lab capacity: 25 samples/week (July 1 – Sept 30, late start due to *trh* internal validation process)
- Set aside samples for studies:
  - o Relayed oysters (Hood Canal 3 to beach near Port Hadlock)
  - o Shucked meat samples (additional 2 samples/week for 8 weeks)
  - o PFGE library expansion (5 new sites, 1 sample each)
