11-201A 11-201B	Review <i>Vv</i> and <i>Vp</i> illnesses, revise <i>Vv</i> control plan	Already integrated under Interim NSSP
13-101 / 13-202	Tiered illness response	Additional illness thresholds and actions taken by Authority
13-203	Annual report of state shellfish harvest	Develop system to collect and report the volume of oysters harvested in Washington (by utilization type)
13-204	Study time-to-temperature controls and regional best practices	As possible, partner with FDA on research studies

Proposal	Topic
09-231	Recognize pathogen reduction processing which reduce risk but are not associated with labeling claims
11-206	ISSC review of CDC <i>Vp</i> illness information
13-200	<i>Vibrio</i> research wish list
13-209	Defines resubmergence and permits the practice if a validated study shows that contaminant levels do not exceed FDA tolerance levels or are consistent with background levels
13-223	Requires control plan revision if a state is not able to meet the 1:100,000 risk per serving standard for <i>Vp</i>
