

## Public Hearing Notice – *Vibrio parahaemolyticus* Control Plan Rule

On **March 11, 2015**, the State Board of Health (Board) will hold a public hearing on revising the *Vibrio parahaemolyticus* Control Plan Rule.

The proposed rule revises the control plan to include more proactive measures to prevent illness and protect public health, clarifies existing requirements, and makes the control plan compliant with National Shellfish Sanitation Program Model Ordinance requirements. The control plan still only applies to oysters harvested in the summer months.

The public hearing is your opportunity to provide comments for the Board to consider.
