







- Run dishwashers and washing machines one at a time.

- Walk over your drainfield often and check for odors or surfacing sewage.
- Direct water from roof downspouts away from your drainfield.
- Keep sprinkler systems and irrigation off your drainfield.

No! Your system doesn't need a miracle cure.
It needs proper everyday care.**

Protect your system from clogged pipes and failure from harsh chemicals. Follow these simple steps:



There's more to gain when you keep them out of the drain.

1 Trash These Items

- Kitchen scraps—use a sink strainer, not a garbage disposal.
- Fats, oils and grease.
- Baby wipes, tissues, paper towels, excessive toilet paper.
- Floss, hair, feminine products, condoms, kitty litter and pet waste.

2 Save Your Money!

Proactive, positive actions good

- Don't use septic additives. They're expensive and not proven to work.
- Don't exceed the label's recommended amount of bleach, detergent and drain de-cloggers.
- Minimize use of bath oils.

Minimize text as much as possible.

3 Take to a Return Center

- Take oil-based paint, harsh chemicals or cleaners to a household hazardous waste facility. Visit www.snoco.org, search "haz waste."
- Take expired or unwanted medications to a secure disposal location. Visit www.snoco.org, search "pharmaceuticals."
