
2010-11 Standards Review Results

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- 2010-11 standards aligned with Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB) Beta Test version (current results not comparable with previous cycles)
- 14 LHJs were reviewed on the PHAB or WA set
 - ▣ 80% average demonstrated for 2011, compare to 56% in 2008
- 20 LHJs (Okanogan did not participate) were reviewed on the Basic set
 - ▣ 73% average demonstrated


Public Health Accreditation Board/WA Sets Review Results

Governmental Public Health System Review Recommendations

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1. Develop and Implement Strategic Plans

RECOMMENDATION

Ensure that all state and local Strategic Plans include objectives that have measurable and time-framed targets. This improvement will provide the capacity to effectively monitor progress on the implementation of the Strategic Plans.

Governmental Public Health System Review Recommendations

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2. Develop and Implement Community Health Improvement Plans

RECOMMENDATION

Establish methods and templates for all health departments to develop and implement a State/Community Health Improvement Plan (SHIP/CHIP) and support health departments' SHIP/CHIP planning and development activities in a systematic way.

Governmental Public Health System Review Recommendations

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3. Implement Quality Improvement

RECOMMENDATION

Ensure that health departments establish plans for conducting quality improvement efforts and for training their staff in quality improvement methods and tools.

Public Health Standards Next Steps & Recommendations

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- Washington continuously adopt the current PHAB Standards in place of the Washington standards
- Drop the 8 Washington only measures. These are program measures about completing steps in the PDSA quality improvement cycle. Consider in future discussions.
- Adopt a second set of standards similar to the 2011 Basic set with a sunset clause

Public Health Standards Next Steps & Recommendations

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- Move to a five year cycle for consistency with PHAB (additional work needed for how to capture a review for all LHJs and maintain system wide view)
- Identify potential options to assist with future standards reviews as consultant services are no longer an option.

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- Standards review complete and results posted online
- Recommendations for the next review cycle
- PHAB open for business today 9-14
- 18 LHJs intend to apply for PHAB accreditation
- RWJ Multi-State Learning Collaborative completed
- Performance Management Centers for Excellence

Public Health Activities & Services Workgroup Update

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- 2010 Public Health Activities and Services Inventory held this summer
 - 35 LHJs and DOH
 - More than 200 activities and services
 - Data now directly uploaded from the surveys
- Data available in October
- New interactive web-based system
 - Will allow users to query all three years of activities and services data across the state and over time

Public Health Indicators Workgroup Update

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- 2011 Public Health Indicators update underway
 - ▣ Air quality, Falls among older adults, Percent in poverty and Youth depression indicators added
- First release of data in September, final in November
- New web-based system
 - ▣ Will allow users to query and display specific indicator information by local health jurisdiction over time
- Release of new indicators data will coincide with the release of the 2010 Public Health Activities and Services Inventory data
