2010 ACTIVITIES & SERVICES CRITERIA

2010 ACTIVITIES & SERVICES HIGHLIGHTS

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- Provided 97,557 childhood vaccinations, 75,134 adult vaccinations and 15,737 travel vaccinations to prevent disease
- Investigated over 41,397 cases of communicable disease
- Treated 14,237 people diagnosed with STDs and notified and treated 7,063 other people to prevent the spread of disease

2010 ACTIVITIES & SERVICES HIGHLIGHTS

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2010 ACTIVITIES & SERVICES HIGHLIGHTS

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- Inspected 49,456 restaurants, grocery stores and food carts for health hazards 59,877 times, with 2,644 of these inspections requiring immediate re-inspection
- Responded to 3,184 reports of failing onsite sewage systems to prevent water contamination
- Licensed 340,993 health care professionals in 79 different health professions for safe services
- Licensed 98 acute care and general hospitals and conducted 54 inspections

2010 ACTIVITIES & SERVICES HIGHLIGHTS

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- Clinical care and case management services to 11,693 children with Special Health Care Needs
- Provided healthy foods and nutrition education to 152,705 mothers and children
- Served 24,157 pregnant and new mothers to promote healthy pregnancies
- Provided family planning services to 20,071 patients
- Performed 8 million genetic screening tests for 82,930 newborns. Identified 134 infants with conditions that otherwise could have disabled them for life

2011 INDICATORS UPDATE

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- 35 Local Public Health Indicators
 - Community Context (1 indicator)
 - Communicable Disease (4 indicators)
 - Prevention and Health Promotion (9 indicators)
 - Environmental Health (3 indicators)
 - Maternal and Child Health (10 indicators)
 - Access to Care (8 indicators)
- New management system
 - Trends - baseline, 2009, 2011
 - Data by LHJ
 - LHJ examples of use with other resources

2011 INDICATORS UPDATE

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- Criteria for selecting indicators
 - Measures important outcomes of public health's work
 - Important to the entire population
 - Uses standard measures from existing data systems
 - Are actionable - local public health can implement activities to improve
 - Can be reported in at least 80% of local health jurisdictions with comparisons to the state
 - Measurable over time to determine trends
 - Understandable



 - Strategic Plans

- DOH as well as Island, Spokane and Whatcom, have submitted letters of intent to apply for PHAB accreditation
