COMMUNITY SUPPORT OF SHIP

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- 240 individuals attended presentations between September 19 and November 10, 2014
- Level of support expressed during the November webinars:

I am in general agreement with the SHIP's approach

18% - Strongly agree

36% - Agree

44% - Unsure/Neutral

2% - Disagree

0% - Strongly Disagree

Agree with measures below

22% - Increase proportion of middle and high school youth who have a healthy weight

16% - Increase number of tribes and local health jurisdictions that are actively participating in the Accountable Communities of Health or regional health collaboratives

57% - Both

4% - Neither

SHIP PUBLIC INPUT THEMES

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Stable funding is needed

- ▣ This idea was expressed frequently by public health professionals

Collaboration, coordination, and partnerships are needed

- ▣ Participants commented that the plan requires close collaboration from tribal, state and local governments and non-profit partners. Several mentioned the need to avoid duplicating efforts.

Raising awareness

- ▣ To succeed, attendees pointed out we need to raise awareness of how the SHIP's long-term visionary solutions can address health issues

Reforming care

- ▣ An equitable, integrated, comprehensive, accessible system of care is needed; one that is actually affordable. And we need an updated name for this idea.

Equity

- ▣ Participants asked that the SHIP talk about ways to reduce gaps and disparities, and address equity as a guiding principle

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- ▣ Final SHIP published January 2015
- ▣ Two-page SHIP summary chapter included in the 2014 Public Health Improvement Plan report, January 2015
- ▣ Refresh membership of SHIP workgroup for action planning and implementation phases by January 2015
