2. **FBI CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS/RAP BACK LEGISLATION – PAULA R. MEYER OR CATHERINE WOODARD – DISCUSSION/ACTION** - Currently, the Uniform Disciplinary Act requires all applicants with out of state addresses to complete an FBI Criminal Background Check. The Nursing Commission and Department of Health are seeking request legislation to expand and use the FBI Rap Back program. The concepts of the legislation and fiscal impact will be presented. The Board of Physical Therapy will be asked if they will support the legislation and commit to adopting rules.
3. **FEDERATION OF STATE BOARDS OF PHYSICAL THERAPY (FSBPT) 2016 UPDATE**
