Why run Immunization Coverage Rate Reports?

Because knowledge is power! When you know your immunization rates, you have the power and information to make them better. Providers who run Immunization Coverage Rate Reports using the Washington State Immunization Information System can easily see how many of their school-age and adolescent patients are up-to-date on vaccines.

Once you know where improvement is needed, you can begin your recall and scheduling process. This encourages those patients to come in, leading to better coverage rates and a healthier community!

How do I run the Coverage Rate Report in the Washington State Immunization Information System?

1. Log in to www.waiis.wa.gov using your username and password.

NOTE: If you do not have a username or password, please contact the IIS Help Desk at 1-800-325-5599

2. Under the left navigation Reports Menu heading, select Report Module.

3. Under the Registry heading, select the Coverage Rate Report.




4. Select "By Ownership" to include your patients only.

5. Select the vaccine Series to run and the Age Range to run it for.

6. Select "Active Only" under Patient Status

7. You may limit the report by any of the criteria listed as needed, including Complete by Vaccine and Series Complete.

8. Click the Create Coverage Report button.
