

Healthy People 2020 National Immunization Goals

Healthy People is a national set of science-based, 10-year goals for improving the health of all Americans.¹ These goals are established by a workgroup of experts from several Federal agencies. [The Immunizations and Infectious Disease \(IID\) objectives](#) work to increase immunization rates and reduce preventable infectious diseases². The objectives shown below include those that closely match the measures assessed for AFIX visits. This is not a full list of all the objectives.
