
### *Pain Management Rule Education Efforts*

#### Overview

- Commission licenses 28,730 physicians and physician assistants
- The Commission adopted the rule prior to the June 30, 2010 deadline
- The pain rule for the Commission went into effect January 2, 2012
- Commission worked with AMDG to develop a four-hour CME package

- 1,713 watched the pain rules video
